- ▶ 38-year-old Sikh lawyer Jagmeet Singh became first non-white politician to head a major political party in Canada - New Democratic Party.
- ▶ *Freedom of Oxford* honour bestowed on Myanmar leader Aung San Suu Kyi in 1997 by Oxford city has been withdrawn as a reaction to her perceived response to plight of Rohingya Muslims in Myanmar. Aung San Suu Kyi's name from Junior Common Room in North Oxford (England) has also been removed.
- ▶ A documentary on Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal, titled 'An Insignificant Man', is to be released in November 2017.
- ▶ According to Forbes magazine, Jeff Bezos (Amazon CEO) Surpassed Bill Gates as richest person in world with worth \$90.6 billion, compared to Gates' \$90.1 billion Worth.
- ▶ Agriculture Ministry has roped in Actor Akshay Kumar to promote government's flagship agriculture schemes like soil health card, crop insurance, Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bhima Yojana, Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchai Yojana etc.
- ▶ Airtel Payments Bank CEO Shashi Arora resigned, after recent controversy over company's alleged violation of rules on using Aadhaar for its electronic know-your-customer (e-KYC) verification process.

-  Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) recently barred Bharti Airtel and Airtel Payments Bank from conducting Aadhaar-based SIM verification of mobile customers using eKYC process, after allegations of Bharti Airtel using Aadhaar-eKYC based SIM verification process to open payments bank accounts of its subscribers without their informed consent.
10. ▶ Anup Vikal resigned as e-Commerce Firm Snapdeal's Chief Financial Officer (CFO) and General Counsel.
  11. ▶ Britain's first Indian-origin Cabinet Minister Priti Patel resigned as International Development Secretary, amid controversies over her secret meetings with Israeli politicians. Additionally, Indian Origin Person Ravinder Singh Bhalla became first ever Sikh mayor of New Jersey's Hoboken city.
  12. ▶ Chairman of Reliance Industries, Mukesh Ambani overtook China's Hui Ka Yan (*Evergrande Group Chairman*) to become Asia's richest person with total wealth of \$42.1 billion, according to Forbes' real time billionaire's list. Globally, Ambani is at 14th spot.
  13. ▶ Credit Card Services Major American Express's CEO Kenneth Chenault would step down in 2018 after 16 years term.
  14. ▶ Cricketer Yuvraj Singh launched *Power of Sports to Shape the Future of Adolescents* campaign in South Asia. It is a UNICEF sports initiative for youngsters.
  15. ▶ Facebook Co-founder Eduardo Saverin has become Singapore's richest person with a net worth of \$10.4 billion. Saverin gave up his US citizenship in 2012.
  16. ▶ Facebook India MD Umang Bedi resigned, with Sandeep Bhushan appointed as interim Facebook India MD.
  17. ▶ First Ever Hindu Chief Justice of Bangladesh, Surendra Sinha resigned amid criticism over a verdict that scrapped Parliament's power to remove judges on grounds of misconduct & incapacity.
  18. ▶ Former India women's cricket team coach and batswoman Sreerupa Bose (Mukherjee) passed away.

He crossed a virtual finish line drawn between the island of Ushant off France's northwest tip and Lizard Point in southwest England at 0145 GMT.

  24. ▶ Indian Actress Anushka Sharma is named PETA's Person of the Year by animal rights organisation People for Ethical Treatment of Animals (PETA), for helping to protect dogs from fireworks to advocating for horses who are forced to pull carriages in Mumbai.
