Admission Policy 2024

(For Admission in Ph.D. program in various disciplines)

The Admission to Ph.D. program in Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Lucknow will be governed by Admission Policy (Ph.D.) 2024.

General Information

- 1. The Admission to the Ph.D. program will be made in the light of UGC Public Notice No. F.4-1(UGC-NET Review Committee)/2024(NET)/140648 dated 27th & 28th March, 2024 (Annexure-I & II) considering National Eligibility Test as Entrance Test for admission to Ph.D. program for Academic Session 2024 as well as Ph.D. Regulations, 2023 (Annexure-III) and its amendment as notified vide letter no. ACD23426-L/BBAU/24 dated 06.11.2024 (Annexure IV). The Admission to the Ph.D. program will be made through University SAMARTH portal.
- UGC-NET/UGC-CSIR NET/National level tests (whichever is applicable) score shall be used for admission to Ph.D. programme. The eligibility of NET qualified candidates for different categories is summarized below:

The University shall take Ph.D. admission in following orders.

- 1. From Category 1
- 2. From Category 2
- 3. From Category 3
 - 2.1 Firstly, the JRF-qualified candidates will be admitted into the Ph.D. programme based on an interview as per Ph.D. Regulations, 2023 of the University.

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2.2 For Candidates who qualify in categories 2 and 3, 70% weightage will be given for test scores (National Level Test Score/Entrance Test Score) and 30% weightage for the interview for admission to Ph.D. programmes. The Ph.D. admission will be based on the combined merit of test scores (National Level Test Score/Entrance Test Score) and the marks obtained in the interview as defined in Ph.D. Regulations, 2023. Candidates will be called for interview in 1:5 ratio based on declared number of category wise seats.

The marks obtained in the NET by the candidates in Categories 2 and 3 will be valid for a period of one year for admission to Ph.D.

- 2.3 Minimum and maximum marks under the category of C and D under the para 4.2.9 of Ph.D. Regulations, 2023 awarded by the D.R.C. shall be 40% and 80% respectively. Marks granted by D.R.C. beyond the said limits to the candidates, reason for this must be recorded in the minutes of the D.R.C. of Department.
- 3. The applicant's candidature is subject to the fulfilment of the minimum eligibility criteria at the time of admission.
- 4. Admission of the candidates for Ph.D. programme is based on their suitability to specific specialization and also subject to fulfilling all other conditions laid down in the respective regulation of the BABASAHEB BHIMRAO AMBEDKAR UNIVERSITY.
- 5. The merit list for the unreserved category seats will comprise of all the candidates in the order of merit including candidates under reserved category, if they come in the unreserved merit. A candidate under reserved category, who figures in the unreserved merit list, is entitled to be considered for admission under the unreserved category. Admission to unreserved category seats will be strictly in the order of merit without excluding candidates belonging to reserved category.
- 6. The Concerned Departmental Research Committee (D.R.C.) shall verify all the relevant certificates/documents submitted by the applicant.
- 7. The Merit list for interview will be prepared based on the total marks obtained in National Level Test Score/Entrance Test Score. Candidates will be called for interview in 1:5 ratio based on declared number of category-wise seats.
- 8. The basis of final shortlisting of candidates for admission will be on the merit of marks obtained in entrance test (70% weightage), and Interview (30%) put together. The Interview component (30 marks) will comprise of-
 - A. Weightage for Academics- 05 Marks

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- Bachelor's degree (% of Marks obtained in UG X 2/100),
- Master's degree (% of Marks obtained in PG X 3/100),
- 04 Year Bachelor's degree Honours with Research (% of Marks obtained in 4 Year UG X 5/100)

B. Weightage for Fellowship etc. -10 Marks

- JRF/Any other National level Fellowship -10 marks or
- M.Phil. +NET-7 marks or
- M.Phil./NET-5 marks
- C. Weightage for Research Proposal -5 Marks
- D. Weightage for Personal Interaction -10 Marks
- 9. All the essential qualifications including NET etc. will be considered as on the date of interview in concerned department.

Eligibility criteria for admission to the Ph.D. Programme: As specified in the Admission Prospectus of the Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University.

Admission Rules

- 1. Each candidate is required to sign a declaration regarding discipline and conduct as per provisions of the Act & Statutes of the University.
- 2. The admission is liable to be cancelled if any information/document provided by the candidate, if found to be fake/incorrect. Strict disciplinary action shall also be taken against such candidates as per university rules.
- 3. The University reserves the right to change/modify the Rules and Regulations of the admission.
- 4. On being called for Interview, the candidates shall have to submit the self-attested copies of following documents on or before the last date prescribed by Departmental Research Committee (D.R.C.) for the purpose:
 - (a) Mark Sheet/Grade Sheet of the qualifying degree course (self-attested).
 - (b) Character Certificate from last attended institute/University. (in original).
 - (c) Migration Certificate (In original) from the competent authority of the University/Institution last attended.
 - (d) SC/ST/EWS/PwD/NRI latest Certificate issued by the Competent Authority (self-attested).
 - (e) Candidates shall bring all the original certificates/relevant documents for verification alongwith self-attested photocopy.
- 5. Applicants seeking admission to more than one course in the University have to submit separate application/Registration forms for each course.

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- 6. As per University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedures for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2022 No. F. No. 1-3/2021(QIP) and Ph.D. Regulations 2023, for taking admission in the Ph.D., it is necessary that the candidate must have passed the PG degree course in the relevant subject/allied subject as listed at Annexure II of prospectus/ Admission Brochure, from a University recognized by the University Grants Commission with 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in UGC 7-point scale [5% relaxation or equivalent grade shall be provided to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/EWS/PwD].
- 7. The marks in the qualifying examination shall be read without rounding off.
- 8. Merely qualifying JRF/NET/Any other National level test/ appearing in the entrance test/interview does not entitle a candidate to claim admission.
- 9. Candidates against whom any disciplinary action has been taken at any stage in his/her earlier academic career shall not be admitted to any course in this University.
- 10. Enrolment of a candidate shall stand cancelled if candidate is held guilty of any cognizable offence. Enrolment may also be cancelled if candidate's conduct is found guilty by the University at any time during tenure of study.
- 11. No candidate shall be entitled to claim admission as a matter of right.
- 12. The Departments of the University may ask the candidates concerned, wherever necessary, to get recognition/equivalence of their degrees/diplomas/ certificates authenticated from the Association of Indian Universities/University Grants Commission/AICTE/Council of Boards of School Education in India (COBSE)/PCI/BCI on his/her own for the purpose of admission in the Department (if Necessary).
- 13. University offers two supernumerary seats in each department to its teaching and non-teaching permanent employees who fulfil basic eligibility as per Ph.D. Regulations 2023. Admission may be given to Foreign/NRI applicants in accordance with Ph.D. Regulations, 2023 of the University and due recommendation of **Coordinator**, **Office for International Affairs**.
- 14. The ratio of part-time seats may not be more than the 20% of the vacant seats subject to the maximum of 10% of sanctioned seats at any point of time for each Department
- 15. In case of non-submission of Transfer/ Migration Certificate (original) on the date of admission, the candidate may be allowed to submit Transfer/ Migration Certificate (original) within 15 days of admission. Failing which their admission is liable to be cancelled.
- 16. Applying to more than one program a candidate is free to apply for admission to as many courses as she/he wishes by applying separately on Application for Ph.D. on SAMARTH Portal provided fulfils all other requirements of eligibility.

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- 17. The Entrance Exam marks (if applicable) of Ph.D. shall be used for shortlisting candidates to be called for interview. Short-listed candidates for Ph.D. admission will have to appear for an interview, alongwith six copies of their research proposal in about minimum 500 words and maximum 2500 words, on dates notified by the University.
- 18. Without research proposal, the candidates will not be interviewed.

19. IN CASE OF A TIE:

The following criteria shall be followed, in sequence to resolve ties, where candidates secure the same marks:

First criterion: Marks obtained by the candidates in the National level test (JRF/NET/any other National level test).

Second criterion: Marks obtained in the degree examination immediately preceding the qualifying degree examination.

Third criterion: Marks obtained in the next lower examination.

20. All disputes pertaining to the admissions shall fall within the jurisdiction of Lucknow.

Reservation Policy

The reservation policy to be followed for admission in academic session 2024-25 will be as per the provisions of the academic ordinance Chapter VII (clause 9) "for the purposes of admission to all courses of study in the university, 50% of the seats shall be reserved for Scheduled caste/ Scheduled tribes (SC/ST) candidates" and 10% seats shall be reserved for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) for admissions in the University as per the letter of MHRD, F.No.19-4/2019-CU.Cdn dated 23.01.2019.

The distribution of seats as per reservation policy is already mentioned in the prospectus.

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
