-  It is an annual award instituted by Government of India since 1995, on 125th Birth Anniversary commemoration year of M K Gandhi.
-  Jury is chaired by PM Narendra Modi. Two eminent members are also part of Jury - Om Birla (Speaker of Lok Sabha), and Bindeshwar Pathak (Founder of Sulabh International).
-  Award carries amount of Rs. 1 crore, a citation, a plaque and an exquisite traditional handicraft/ handloom item.

11. ▶ **Gita Mittal** (Former CJ of J&K HC) has been declared as one of two recipients of **Arline Pacht Global Vision Award** for 2021, along with Margarita Luna Ramos from Mexico.

-  International Association of Women Judges (IAWJ) instituted this award in 2016. Gita Mittal is first Indian judge to receive this award.
-  At present, Gita Mittal is Chairperson of Broadcasting Content Complaints Council (BCCC).

19. ▶ Bangladeshi Nobel Peace Prize winner **Muhammad Yunus** will receive **Olympic Laurel** at Tokyo Olympic Games 2020, the second time the trophy will be awarded. Yunus founded the *Grameen Bank* in 1983 and was awarded Nobel Peace Prize in 2006.

✍ Olympic Laurel is a distinction awarded by International Olympic Committee, to honour those who have *made significant achievements in education, culture, development and peace through sport*. It was introduced in 2016.

20. ▶ Bengaluru teacher Shyamala Ganesh, the former director of the Japanese Language School, will be conferred *Order of the Rising Sun, Gold and Silver Rays*, by Japanese Govt.
21. ▶ Bhutan's India-assisted Mangdechhu Hydroelectric Project has been conferred with **Brunel Medal** awarded by London-based Institution of Civil Engineers (ICE), for being a hallmark of excellence in civil engineering.
22. ▶ Bollywood Actor **Anupam Kher** won Best Actor award at New York City International Film Festival (US), for short film *Happy Birthday*.
 - ✎ The film also won Best Short Film award.
23. ▶ Cambridge University (UK) professors **Shankar Balasubramanian** (Indian-Origin) and **David Klenerman** won 1 million euro (\$1.22 million) **Millennium Technology Prize 2020**, for developing a super-fast DNA sequencing technique that paved way for revolutionary healthcare advances.

 - ✎ The Alexander Dalrymple Award has been named after first hydrographer of Admiralty, instituted in 2006.

26. ▶ Crown Prince of Abu Dhabi Sheikh Mohamed Bin Zayed Al Nahyan honoured Indian-origin businessman **Yusuffali MA** and 11 other individuals with Abu Dhabi's top civilian award for their contributions to community. Yusuffali is CMD of Abu Dhabi-based retail chain LuLu Group.
27. ▶ Engineers India Limited (EIL) CMD RK Sabharwal has been honoured with highest civilian award of **Mongolia**, *The Order of Polar Star*, for outstanding contribution towards establishment of first-ever oil refinery in Mongolia.
 - ✍ Earlier, PM Narendra Modi announced line of credit worth USD 1 billion to Mongolia, during his visit. It was later decided to use this Line of Credit for establishment of first Oil Refinery in Mongolia.
 - ✍ EIL later secured contract for providing Project Management Consultancy (PMC) services for 1.5 MMTPA Grassroot refinery project.
28. ▶ European Patent Office (EPO) honoured Indian-American chemist **Sumita Mitra** with European Inventor Award 2021, in *Non-EPO countries* category.
 - ✍ Mitra was first to successfully integrate nanotechnology into dental materials to produce stronger and more aesthetically pleasing fillings, now used globally.

 - ✍ Mohun Bagan were declared champions in IFA Shield campaign in 1911. This marked first time a native club defeated British and British-Indian teams in a football tournament.
 - ✍ Since 2001, July 29 is celebrated as Mohun Bagan Day, in honour of club's victory over East Yorkshire Regiment in 1911 IFA Shield Final.
31. ▶ Former Kerala Health Minister **KK Shailaja** has been honored with *Central European University (CEU) Open Society Prize 2021*, given to organizations /individuals whose achievements have contributed to the creation of an open society.
32. ▶ French architects **Anne Lacaton** and **Jean-Philippe Vassal**, founders of French studio Lacaton & Vassal, have been named 2021 winners of **Pritzker Architecture Prize**.

✎ Pritzker Architecture Prize is awarded annually to exceptional architect(s), Founded in 1979 by Jay A. Pritzker and sponsored by Hyatt Foundation. It is often referred to as Nobel Prize of architecture.

✎ It carries monetary grant of US\$100000.

33. ▶ French novelist **David Diop** won **International Booker Prize 2021** for English Translation of his book *Frere d' ame*, translated into english as *At Night All Blood is Black*, by *Anna Moschovakis*.

✎ He is first French winner of Booker prize, which is awarded for a book translated into English and published in UK or Ireland.

✎ International Booker Prize (formerly *Man Booker International Prize*) is an international literary award hosted in UK, given Since 2016 to a single book translated into English and published in UK / Ireland, with £50,000 prize shared equally between author and translator.

✎ It is sepeate from Booker Prize, Earlier Booker–McConnell Prize (1969–2001) and Man Booker Prize (2002–2019). It is a literary prize awarded each year for best novel written in English and published in UK / Ireland.

37. ▶ IIT Khagragpur Professor **Suman Chakraborty** has been selected for 30th GD Birla Award for Scientific Research, for his outstanding contribution to engineering science and its applications in developing technologies for affordable healthcare.

 About the award -

 Instituted in 1991 by K K Birla Foundation, this award recognises eminent Indian scientists below age of 50 years, for their outstanding contributions to science / technology. It carries cash prize of 5 lakh.

38. ▶ India's Rumana Sinha Sehgal won Nelson Mandela World Humanitarian Award 2021 by Diplomatic Mission Global Peace, for her contribution to field of developing innovative and functional green products by recycling varied materials and non-biodegradable materials.

39. ▶ India-Born **Tahera Qutbuddin** became first Indian to win **Sheikh Zayed Book Award 2021** in category *Arabic Culture in Other Languages*, for her book *Arabic Oration: Art and Function*'.

40. ▶ Indian Econometric Society (TIES) Trust named 2 noted economic scholars for **Prof. C.R. Rao Centenary Gold Medal award** - **Jagdish Bhagwati** (Columbia University) and **C Rangarajan** (Former chairman of Economic Advisory Council of PM and former RBI

governor).

 The medal was instituted by TIES Trust to mark 100th birthday celebration of renowned mathematician statistician CR Rao (on September 10, 2020).

41. ▶ Indian Graphic artist **Anand Radhakrishnan** won **Will Eisner Comic Industry Award**, considered the Oscars equivalent of the comics world.

 He won in *Best Painter/Multimedia Artist (interior art)* category, sharing the award with UK-based colourist John Pearson. They won for their work on UK-based author Ram V's 145-page graphic novel *Blue In Green*, published in October 2020 by Image Comics.

87. ▶ United Nations Global Compact recognised India's Sumant Sinha (ReNew Power Chairman & MD) as one of ten 2021 SDG Pioneers, for exceptional work in advancing Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) through implementation of UN Global Compact Ten Principles on human rights, environment, labor, and anti-corruption.

88. ▶ Vaccine maker Serum Institute of India (SII) Chairman Cyrus Poonawalla has been honoured with **Lokmanya Tilak National Award** for 2021, given by Lokmanya Tilak Smarak Trust, for his work during COVID-19 pandemic.
89. ▶ World number two tennis player **Naomi Osaka** of Japan has been named “**Sportswoman of the Year**” at the **2021 Laureus World Sports Awards**. This is Osaka’s second Laureus Sports Awards. In 2019, she won the “**Breakthrough of the Year**” award.
90. ▶ Zimbabwe Author **Tsitsi Dangarembga** won **PEN Pinter Prize 2021**, given annually *to a British writer or a writer resident in Britain of outstanding literary merit*.

 This award was launched in 2009 by English PEN in honour of late Nobel Literature Prize-winning playwright Harold Pinter.
