Meetings

- 1. 2nd UN Global Sustainable Transport Conference will be held in October 2021 in Beijing (China), to focus on opportunities, challenges and solutions towards achieving sustainable transport worldwide.
 - 1st Global Sustainable Transport Conference was held in 2016 in Ashgabat (Turkmenistan).
- 2. 31st Meet of 30-member NATO (North Atlantic Treaty Organization) summit held in Brussels (Belgium).
 - NATO leaders declared that China poses a constant security challenge and is working to undermine global order.
- 3. 47th G7 summit held in Cornwall (England), Presided by UK, with theme Build Back Better.
 - 🔪 UK had invited India, Australia, South Korea and South Africa as Guest Countries for G7 Summit 2021.
 - Narendra Modi Attended the Summit Virtually.
- 4. *UN Congress on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice* 2021 Held in Japanese city of Kyoto.
- 5. G7 Foreign Ministers' Meeting (in-person) held in **London** (UK), attended by External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar on India's Behalf.
 - Also, 1st India-France-Australia Trilateral Foreign Ministerial Dialogue held in London, on sidelines of the G7 Foreign Ministers' Meet.
 - 🥄 G7 Nations Include Canada, France, Germany, Italy, Japan, UK, and US.
 - Number 1 Indian attended the Summit on a special invitation from UK.

- 6. India-Finland Virtual Summit attended by PM Narendra Modi and Finland PM Sanna Marin. Notably -
 - Tinnish telecom equipment maker Nokia partnered with Microsoft, Amazon web services and Google so as to develop a new cloud-based 5G radio solution, with its radio access network (RNA) technology.
- 7. Indian PM Narendra Modi and UK PM Boris Johnson attended Virtual India-UK Summit. Both nations adopted an ambitious India-UK Roadmap to 2030 to steer cooperation for next 10 years. MoUs/Declarations -
 - Naunch of an Enhanced Trade Partnership
 - Noint Declaration of Intent on cooperation in the fields of Digital and Technology
 - Natatement of Principles on new joint work between India and the UK on the India Energy Security Scenarios Calculator
 - NOUs -
 - 🔪 India-UK Global Innovation Partnership
 - 🥄 India-UK Migration and Mobility Partnership
 - Name of the Cooperation in field of Telecommunications/ICT
 - Customs Cooperation and Mutual Administrative Assistance in customs matters
 - Nedical products regulation
 - Nharmacopoeial Cooperation
- 8. Indian PM Narendra Modi attended 2021 Leaders' virtual Climate Summit, organized by US. Representatives from 38 Nations attended. Notable pledges made by Large Economies -
 - VS -
 - Nannounced to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 50% 52%, relative to the level of 2005, by 2030.
 - Numerated and Submitted and Nationally Determined Contribution to UN Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC).
 - Number 1 India Reaffirmed its target of installing 450 gigawatts of renewable energy by 2030.
 - New European Union announced to reduce emissions by at least 55% by 2030 and by 100% by 2050.
 - Note: China Reaffirmed its pledges to peak its emissions by 2030 and reach carbon neutrality by 2060.
- 9. PM Narendra Modi Attended Virtual India-EU Leaders' Meeting, with participation of all 27 EU Member Nations. This is first time EU hosted a meeting with India in EU+27 format.
 - 🔪 India and EU agreed to resume discussions about a free trade agreement (FTA), 8 years after the talks got stalled.
 - \ India and EU launched comprehensive 'Connectivity Partnership', focused on enhancing digital, energy, transport and people-to-people connectivity.
- 10. PM Narendra Modi attended first QUAD (Quadrilateral Framework) Leaders' Summit, attended by India, US, Australia and Japan.

- VUAD grouping of India, USA, Australia and Japan, aims to safeguard interests of democratic nations in Indo-Pacific region and address global challenges and Chinese aggression.
- 11. PM Narendra Modi inaugurated 2nd edition of Maritime India Summit 2021, held Virtually.
 - Non this occasion, *Real-time Vessel Tracking System* was launched, to help seafarers and fishermen. This system has been named as "Sagar-Manthan: Mercantile Marine Domain Awareness Centre (MMDAC)".
 - Note The summit ended with March 4 observed as Chabahar Day, marking importantce of Chabahar Port in Iran.
- 12. Raksha Mantri Rajnath Singh attended Virtual 8th ASEAN Defence Ministers Meeting (ADMM) Plus.
 - It is an annual meeting of Defence Ministers of 10 ASEAN (Association of Southeast Asian Nations) countries and 8 dialogue partners Australia, China, India, Japan, New Zealand, Republic of Korea, Russia and US.
 - Nunei is Chair of the ADMM Plus forum this year.
