- ▶ *Henri Marie Dondra* has been named prime minister of Central African Republic.
- ▶ **Anup Chandra Pandey** has been named as new **Election Commissioner** (EC) of India.
 - ▶ Election Commission of India consists of a Chief Election Commissioner (Sushil Chandra Currently) and 2 Election Commissioners (Rajiv Kumar and now Anup Chandra Pandey).
- ▶ **Deepak Das** has been appointed as new Controller General of Accounts (CGA).
- ▶ **Ebrahim Raisi** has been elected as **Iran's** new president.
- ▶ **Issac Herzog** has been named as new (11th) President of **Israel**, succeeding Reuven Rivlin.
- ▶ **Jeff Bezos** stepped down as Amazon's CEO, exactly 27 years after he founded e-commerce Giant Amazon in a garage in West Bellevue, Wash. **Andy Jassy** has succeeded him as new Amazon CEO.
- ▶ **Kalyan Narayan Bhattacharjee** has been appointed as new Lokayukta of Tripura.
- ▶ **La. Ganesan** is named as new Governor of Manipur.
 - ▶ Earlier, Sikkim Governor Ganga Prasad was given additional charge as Governor of Manipur, who held it for approx 15 days.
- ▶ **Munishwar Nath Bhandari** is named as Acting Chief Justice of **Allahabad High Court**.
 - ▶ He replaces Sanjay Yadav, who retired after short tenure of 13 days.

10. ▶ **Naftali Bennett** has been named new (13th) Prime Minister of **Israel**, replacing Benjamin Netanyahu.
11. ▶ **Pradeep Chandran Nair** has been named as new (21st) Director General of **Assam Rifles** (known as Sentinels of North-East).
 Assam Rifles is oldest paramilitary force of India, dating back to 1835 under British Raj, raised under name Cachar Levy. Present name *Assam Rifles* has been used since 1917.
12. ▶ **Robinah Nabbanja** has been named as **Uganda**'s first female Prime Minister.
13. ▶ **Satish Namdeo Ghormade** has been appointed as New Vice Chief of Indian Navy.
14. ▶ **Sher Bahadur Deuba** has been appointed as Nepal's Prime Minister for his 5th term.
15. ▶ **Ukhnaa Khurelsukh** (*Former Mongolian Prime Minister*), has been elected as country's new democratically elected president.
16. ▶ **Vivek Ram Chaudhari** is named as New Vice Chief of Indian Air Force. Also, Ballabha Radha Krishna will head Western Command and RJ Duckworth will head Central Air Command.
17. ▶ Ajai Singh has been named as new Commander-in-Chief of Andaman & Nicobar Command (CINCAN), the only tri-service theatre command of Armed Forces.
18. ▶ Apurva Chandra has been appointed as Secretary in Ministry of Information & Broadcasting.
19. ▶ Australia's Geoff Allardice has been named Interim CEO of International Cricket Council (ICC), after India's Manu Sawhney resigned from post.
20. ▶ BJP's **Basavaraj Bommai** has been named New (23rd) Chief Minister of **Karnataka**, after B. S. Yediyurappa had resigned from post.
21. ▶ Bashar al-Assad has been appointed as President of Syria for his fourth term.
22. ▶ Bharatiya Janata Party's **Pushkar Singh Dhami** has been appointed as new (11th) **Chief Minister of Uttarakhand**, replacing Tirath Singh Rawat.
23. ▶ C. Vijayakumar (HCL CEO) has been appointed as managing director of HCL Tech for 5 years, after Founder Shiv Nadar resigned as MD.
24. ▶ CBDT Member **Jagannath Bidyadhar Mohapatra** has been given additional charge as chairman of Central Board of direct taxes (CBDT), for three months, upon completion of Pramod Chandra Mody's tenure.
25. ▶ Choguel Kokalla Maïga has been named Transitional Prime Minister of Mali.
 He was named Prime Minister of Transition by coup leader & newly appointed President of Transition Assimi Goïta.
26. ▶ Cleopas Dlamini has been named as new Prime Minister of Southern African Nation **Eswatini** (formerly *Swaziland*).
27. ▶ Foreign Minister of Maldives, **Abdulla Shahid** has been elected as President of **76th** session of UN General Assembly (UNGA).
 He will succeed Turkey's Volkan Bozkir, who was President of 75th session of UNGA.
28. ▶ Former Bombay HC judge V M Kanade has been named as Maharashtra's New Lokayukta.
29. ▶ Former SC judge **Arun Kumar Mishra** has been named as Chairman of **National Human Rights Commission** (NHRC).

30. ▶ Govt appointed **Aashish Chandorkar** as Counsellor in India's Permanent Mission in World Trade Organisation. He is director of Bengaluru-based policy think tank Smahi Foundation of Policy and Research.

36. ▶ IIT Kanpur faculty Mukesh Sharma has been appointed as an honorary member of the World Health Organisation's (WHO) Global Air Pollution and Health – Technical Advisory Group (GAPH-TAG).
