- ▶ *Invest India* initiative of Government won top United Nations Investment Promotion Award in recognition of its efforts to boost investments in renewable energy sector in India. It was announced in Geneva (Switzerland) at inauguration of World Investment Forum organised by UN Convention on Trade and Development (UNCTAD).
- ▶ 2018 Seoul Peace Prize has been conferred on Indian PM Narendra Modi, for his dedication to improving international cooperation, raising global economic growth, accelerating the Human Development of people of India.
 - ▶ Seoul Peace Prize was established in 1990 to commemorate the success of the 24th Olympic Games held in Seoul (South Korea).

- ▶ Anna Burns became First Northern Irish author to win 2018 Man Booker Prize (Fiction), after she won it for her novel *Milkman*. 'Milkman' tells story of a young girl's affair with an older man. Award consists cash prize of £50,000 (~\$65,000).
 - ▶ Man Booker Prize for Fiction (formerly known as the Booker–McConnell Prize and commonly known simply as Booker Prize) is a literary prize awarded each year for best original novel written in the English language and published in the UK.

8. ▶ Arshdeep Singh (Punja) won Wildlife Photographer of Year award in 10 Years and Under category given by UK's Natural History Museum. He won the award for the picture titled 'Pipe Owls', which showed two spotted owlets sitting inside an old waste-pipe in Punjab Kapurthala.

At the same occasion, Dutch photographer Marsel van Oosten won Wildlife Photographer of Year award, for his photo of critically endangered golden snub-nosed monkeys in China, titled 'The Golden Couple'.

9. ▶ Ashis Mukherjee, faculty member in Tezpur University won Indian National Science Academy (INSA) Teachers Award (2018), for his consistent high level of inspiring students to take up careers in Science and Technology.
10. ▶ Athletics Federation of India will be awarded FICCI (Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry) India Sports Awards 2018, in category of Best National Sports Federation (NSF).
11. ▶ Author Amitav Ghosh honoured with 54th Jnanpith Award for 2018, an award for outstanding contribution to literature. Selection committee was chaired by novelist Pratibha Ray.
12. ▶ Bharti Enterprises chairman Sunil Bharti Mittal became first Indian to receive ESCP Europe's highest honour 'Doctor Honoris Causa' for his innovative entrepreneurship and philanthropy in education.
13. ▶ Breakthrough Prize Foundation announced recipients of 2019 Breakthrough Prize, known as the "Oscars of Science,".

Each prize is \$3 million and presented in the fields of Life Sciences (up to four per year), Fundamental Physics (one per year) and Mathematics(one per year). Awardees are -

14. ▶ Catriona Gray of Philippines crowned as Miss Universe 2018, with pageant held in Bangkok (Thailand).
- 1st Runner-Up - Tamaryn Green (South Africa)

15. ▶ Croatia's Footballer Luca Modrich won Ballon d'Or, prestigious honor of football. He was instrumental in Croatia's historic run to FIFA World Cup final (defeated by France). In past decade, the noted award has been rotating between Lionel Messi and Cristiano Ronaldo. Women's Ballon d'Or was won by Norway's Ada Hegerberg, as inaugural edition of Women's Ballon d'Or. France's Kylian Mbappe won Trophee Kopa (best young player under 21 years age) at Ballon d'Or ceremony.

18. ▶ European Union selected Department of European Studies (DES) of Manipal Academy of Higher Education (MAHE) for prestigious Jean Monnet Centre of Excellence (CoE) Award.
- It became only Centre of Excellence in European Studies in India.
- It grants close to one lakh euros for various activities planned for 3 years.
- Earlier, MAHE had been titled as an Institute of Eminence by Government of India.
19. ▶ Former Indian Cricketer Bishan Singh Bedi honoured with Dr.M.A.Chidambaram Birth Centenary Award in Chennai, instituted by MAC Charities in memory of the former BCCI president M.A.Chidambaram.
20. ▶ Goa's Prathamesh Maulingkar became first Asian/Indian to win Mister Supernational title, after he won 2018 edition in a competition held in Poland.

21. ▶ Guadeloupean author Maryse Conde has been honored with New Academy Prize in Literature, an alternative award formed in protest to Nobel Literature Prize.

36. ▶ Kleinman Center for Energy Policy at University of Pennsylvania School of Design (USA) awarded its 4th annual Carnot Prize to India's Piyush Goyal, Minister of Railways & Coal (former Minister of Power), Recognising his work for bringing pathbreaking transformations in India's energy sector.
 - ▶ Carnot Prize is named after French physicist Nicolas Sadi Carnot who recognised that power of the steam engine would "produce a great revolution" in human development.
 - ▶ 2018 Carnot Prize Honors India's work towards mission *24x7 Affordable, Environment Friendly Power for all*.
 - ▶ India has eliminated decades of darkness in more than 19,000 villages on 28th April, 2018.
 - ▶ With Saubhagya Programme, last-mile connectivity to every household in the villages is being fast tracked, with 51% of the 3.1 crore rural households electrified.
 - ▶ India's Massive thrust to green energy is reflected in India's 175 GW target by 2022, being world's largest renewable expansion programme with 72 GW already achieved.
 - ▶ Carnot Prize recognises India's *solid footing to reach a 40% renewable mix by 2030*.
 - ▶ In last 4 years, energy efficiency has become a people's movement in India, making the Government's UJALA scheme the world's largest LED distribution programme. 130 crore LED bulbs have been already distributed.
37. ▶ Madhya Pradesh Government conferred its annual Tansen Samman upon eminent Sitar Player Manju Mehta.
38. ▶ Malayalam author Benyamin's novel Jasmine Days won JCB Prize for Literature, consisting a trophy and 25 lakhs as prize money. Benyamin, earlier won Kerala Sahitya Akademi Award for Aadujeevitham.

44. ▶ Mexican government honoured Indian academician Shyama Prasad Ganguly with "Orden Mexicana del Águila Azteca" (Mexican Order of the Aztec Eagle), the highest civilian honour given to a foreigner by Mexico. He was awarded for disseminating Spanish language and Mexican culture to strengthen Mexico-India cultural relations. He is first Indian Academician to get this award.

✎ Facts About Nobel prizes -

✎ In 2018, it was for first time in 70 years of Nobel Prizes, that no *Literature Prize* was given. It was announced by Swedish Academy after a recent sexual assault scandal. It has now been postponed to 2019.

✎ Background -

- ✎ Will of Swedish scientist Alfred Nobel established five Nobel prizes in 1895 - Chemistry, Literature, Peace, Physics, and Physiology or Medicine, first awarded in 1901.
- ✎ In 1968, Sweden's central bank Sveriges Riksbank established the Sveriges Riksbank Prize in Economic Sciences in Memory of Alfred Nobel, which, although not being a Nobel Prize, has become informally known as *Nobel Prize in Economics*.

✎ Physics -

- ✎ Granted by Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences
- ✎ 2 women have been awarded Physics Prize so far.
- ✎ Youngest - Australian-British physicist Lawrence Bragg (25 years age), awarded in 1915 together with his father.
- ✎ India's C. V. Raman was awarded Physics Nobel in 1930, For his work on scattering of light and for discovery of effect named after him.

✎ Chemistry

- ✎ Granted by Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences
- ✎ 4 women have been awarded the Chemistry Prize so far.
- ✎ 1 person, Frederick Sanger, has been awarded the Chemistry Prize twice, in 1958 and in 1980.
- ✎ Youngest - France's Frédéric Joliot (35 years age), awarded in 1935.

51. ▶ Noted Actor Amitabh Bachchan has been awarded 3rd third Sayaji Ratna Award, established by Baroda Management Association in memory of erstwhile Baroda ruler Sayajirao Gaekwad III.
52. ▶ Noted Amputee Athlete Arunima Sinha awarded an honorary doctorate by University of Strathclyde of United Kingdom in Glasgow (Scotland). She has been awarded for her inspirational achievements in mountaineering. In 2013, she became world's first woman amputee to climb Mount Everest.
53. ▶ Noted Indian Origin French scholar Jawahar Lal Sarin presented with France's highest civilian honour Chevalier de la Lgion d'Honneur, for his outstanding contribution to enhancing Indo-French cultural cooperation and promoting French language. He is president of Alliance française de Delhi's governing body.
54. ▶ Noted Malayalam novelist M Mukundan selected for Kerala government's highest literary award 'Ezhuthachan Puraskaram' for this year.
55. ▶ Noted jurist Fali S. Nariman has been awarded 19th Lal Bahadur Shastri National Award for Excellence in Public Administration. He is internationally recognised jurist on international arbitration. He has been awarded Padma Bhushan (1991), Padma Vibhushan (2007) and Gruber Prize for Justice (2002).
56. ▶ Noted music director Mohammed Zahur Khayyam Hashmi, famously known as Khayyam won 2018 Hridaynath Award for Lifetime Achievement, by Maharashtra Govt.
57. ▶ Novak Djokovic (Serbia) and Simona Halep (Romania) named as 2018 International Tennis Federation (ITF) world champions by International Tennis Federation (ITF). It is Djokovic's 6th honour and Halep's first time with this honour.
58. ▶ Odia hockey player Lilima Minz selected for Ekalavya Puraskar 2018 by Karnataka based by IMPaCT, social wing of IMFA. It comprises of a cash prize of Rs 5 lakh along with a citation. 2 other sportswomen felicitated - Weight lifter Jhili Dalabehera and Badminton player Rutuparna Panda.
59. ▶ Pakistani Nobel Peace Prize-winner Malala Yousafzai honored by 2018 Gleitsman Award from Harvard's Kennedy School in Cambridge, Massachusetts (USA) for her work promoting girls' education. It provides \$125,000 monetary Prize.
