- Tri Nation Table Top Anti-Narcotics & Maritime Search and Rescue exercise (Exercise Shield TTX2021) held between Maldives, Sri Lanka and India Navies, in virtual mode for the first time, with Indian Navy as lead agency and coordinated by Maritime Warfare Centre Mumbai.
- 2. > 12th Indo-Russia joint Army exercise INDRA-21 held at Volgograd (Russia).
 - Note that 12th edition of exercise **INDRA NAVY 21**, biennial maritime exercise between **Indian** Navy and **Russian** Navy was also held recently in Baltic Sea, attended by INS Tabar on India's Behalf. It also attended Russia Navy's 325th Navy Day celebrations.
- 3. > 12th edition of exercise INDRA NAVY 21, biennial maritime exercise between Indian Navy and Russian Navy held in Baltic Sea, attended by INS Tabar on India's Behalf. It also attended Russia Navy's 325th Navy Day celebrations.
- 4. 1st bilateral Naval exercise AL Mohed AL Hindi, between Indian and Saudi Arabian Navy held at King Abdulaziz Naval base in Al Jubail (Saudi Arabia).
- 5. > 2nd edition of exercise Zair-Al-Bahr between Indian Navy and Qatar Navy conducted in Persian Gulf.
- 6. 5th edition of Indo- Kazakhstan Joint Training Exercise KAZIND-21 began at Aisha Bibi (Kazakhstan), to last till 11 September 2021.
- 7. > 7th edition of biennial event Indian Ocean Naval Symposium (IONS), hosted by French Navy at La Réunion.

IONS was initiated by Indian Navy in 2008, to enhance maritime cooperation among Navies of littoral states of Indian Ocean Region. France has assumed Chairmanship in June 2021, for 2 years.

🔪 Réunion Island is a French department in Indian Ocean, known for its volcanic, rainforested interior, coral reefs and beaches.

8. > As per SIPRI Yearbook 2021 -

9 nuclear armed states (US, Russia, UK, France, China, India, Pakistan, Israel and North Korea) together possessed estimated 13080 nuclear weapons at start of 2021, marking a decrease from 13400 estimation at beginning of 2020. However, number of deployed nuclear weapons increased to 3825, from 3720 last year.

9. DRDO flight tested a New Generation Nuclear Capable Ballistic Missile **Agni P (Prime)**, as is a new generation advanced variant of Agni class of missiles. It is a canisterised missile with range capability between 1,000 and 2,000 kms.

10. Defence Acquisition Council (DAC), under Chairmanship of Raksha Mantri Rajnath Singh, approved issue of RFP for construction of 6 Conventional Submarines under **Project P 75 (I)**, under Strategic Partnership Model, at cost 43000 Crores.

🔪 It is first case processed under Strategic Partnership model, and will be one of largest 'Make in India' projects.

🔪 DAC also approved proposals concerning Capital Acquisitions of various equipment, amounting approx 6000 crores.

11. Govt approved a long-pending proposal to restructure nearly 200-year-old Ordnance Factory Board that operates 41 ammunition and military equipment production facilities into seven state-owned corporate entities, to improve its accountability, efficiency and competitiveness. 7 new entities will include -

12. Indian Air Force formally inducted Rafale aircraft into 101 Squadron at Air Force Station Hasimara in Eastern Air Command.

101 Squadron is second IAF Squadron to be equipped with Rafale aircraft. It was formed on 01 May 1949 at Palam, with active participation in 1965 and 1971 Indo-Pak wars.

Solution 1: No.17 Golden Arrows (Ambala). In September 2020, IAF inducted first batch of five Rafales of 36 jets, contracted under a €7.87 billion Inter-Governmental Agreement signed in September 2016.

13. Indian Coast Guard (ICG) Ship **Vigraha**, seventh in series of Offshore Patrol Vessels (OPVs), has been commissioned by Raksha Mantri Rajnath Singh in Chennai.

🔪 It has been designed and built indigenously by Larsen & Toubro Ship Building Limited.

14. Indian Coast Guard inducted Advanced Light Helicopters (ALH) Mk-III in its fleet, which are indigenously manufactured by Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL).

🔪 The helicopters are capable of undertaking embarked operations from ships which will enhance Coast Guard capabilities.

15. Indian Naval Ship Tabar commenced deployment to several Nations in Africa and Europe. Along with PASSEX Exercises with host navies, it will also participate in bilateral exercises like Ex Konkan with Royal Navy (UK), Ex Varuna with French Navy and Ex Indra with Russian Navy.

16. Indian Naval Ship Talwar participated in *Exercise Cutlass Express 2021*, conducted along East Coast of Africa.

🥄 It is an annual exercise conducted to promote maritime security in East Africa and Western Indian Ocean.

2021 edition of the exercise involves participation of 12 Eastern African countries, US, UK, India and various international organisations.

- 17. ► Indian Naval Ship Trikand participated in First ever India-European Union Joint Navel Exercise, **IN EUNAVFOR**, in Gulf of Aden. European Nations Participating in Exercise are Italy, Spain and France.
- 18. Indian Navy participated in 20th edition of US Navy-led Southeast Asia Cooperation and Training (SEACAT) exercise in Singapore, with participation of 20 other partner nations as well.
- 19. Indian Navy participated in bilateral exercise with UAE Navy off the coast of Abu Dhabi, named **Zayed Talwar 2021**.

20. Indian Navy participated in sea phase of Exercise Malabar 2021, along with Navies from US, Japan and Australia.

Malabar series of maritime exercise commenced in 1992 as an India - US Exercise, Joined by Japan in 2015 and Australia in 2020.
21. Indian Navy's oldest hydrographic survey ship INS Sandhayak has been decommissioned, after serving for 40 years.

22. Indo-UK Joint Naval Exercise Konkan 2021 held in the English Channel, attended by INS Tabar on Indian Navy's Behalf.

23. Misc. Defence News (July 2021) -

- First lot of 12 Short Span Bridging System (SSBS)-10 m, developed by Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), in association with L&T Ltd, has been inducted into Indian Army. The 12 bridges are part of 102 SSBS-10 m to be built by L&T Ltd.
- Israeli Firm Rafael Advanced Defense Systems unveiled Sea Breaker, a 5th generation precision-guided missile system, which can precisely target sea and land targets up to a range of 300 kilometres.
- Ninistry of Defence implemented SPARSH (System for Pension Administration (Raksha)), as an integrated system for automation of sanction and disbursement of defence pension.
- 🔪 Indian Army named a firing range at Gulmarg in Baramulla district (J&K) after Bollywood actress Vidya Balan.
- Indian Navy received first two of its MH-60R Multi Role Helicopters (MRH) from US Navy, manufactured by Lockheed Martin as an all-weather helicopter designed to support multiple missions.
- Note: The second second
- Indian Navy received its 10th anti-submarine warfare and patrol aircraft P-8I Poseidon from US-based Boeing. Ministry of Defence had initially signed contract with Boeing for 8 *P-8I* aircraft in 2009 for Navy, which was later extended to 4 additional P-8I aircraft, in 2016.
- Normal Stress Construction Action Act
- 🔪 Russia successfully test-fired its new advanced S-500 air defence missile systems.
- Indian Navy recieved first two Sikorsky MH-60R multi-role helicopters from US, as part of 24 Multi Role Helicopters (MRH) deal with Lockheed Martin (US), valued \$2.4 billion.
- 🔪 Indian Navy participated in a two-day bilateral Passage Exercise (PASSEX) with UK's Royal Navy Carrier Strike Group.
- 🔪 Indian Naval Ship Saryu participated in coordinated patrol (CORPAT) with Indonesian Navy, in its 36th edition.
- 24. Misc. Defence News (June 2021) -
 - Notian Army observed 100th anniversary of raising of Army Educational Corps (AEC) on 01 June 2021.
 - 🔪 Iran's largest navy ship *The Kharg*, sank after catching fire in Gulf of Oman.
 - 🔪 North Atlantic Treaty Organisation (NATO) organized *Steadfast Defender 21 war games* military exercises.
 - 🔪 31st edition of India-Thailand Coordinated Patrol (Indo-Thai CORPAT) between Indian and Thai Navies has been conducted.

- Defence Minister Rajnath Singh approved policy on *archiving*, *declassification*, *and compilation*, *publication of war and operations histories*. Under this, each organisation under Ministry will transfer records such as war diaries and letters of proceedings to History Division, for proper archival.
- Ministry of Defence signed contract with Goa Shipyard Ltd, for construction of two Pollution Control Vessels (PCVs) for Indian Coast Guard (ICG), at cost of 583 crores. These are scheduled for delivery by November 2024 and May 2025 respectively. At present, ICG has three PCVs in its fleet at Mumbai, Visakhapatnam and Porbander.
- Defence Minister Rajnath Singh reviewed progress of construction of first Indigenous Aircraft Carrier (IAC) built by Cochin Shipyard Ltd, at Kochi. IAC will be commissioned as INS Vikrant in 2022.
- 🔪 Ukraine and North Atlantic Treaty Organisation (NATO) launched Joint *Sea Breeze Drills* in Black Sea, despite Russian Protest.
- A integrated bilateral exercise between Indian and US Forces in Indian Ocean Region has been concluded. Indian Navy along with Indian Air Force participated with US Navy Carrier Strike Group.
- 🥄 Turkey and Azerbaijan held joint military drills *Mustafa Kemal Ataturk 2021* in Baku.
- 25. ▶ Misc. Defence News / Events (August 2021)-
 - Cordnance Factory Tiruchirappalli launched new 7.62 X 39mm portable weapon called *TriCa (Trichy Carbine)*, a mini version of the Trichy Assault Rifle (TAR).
 - NS Khanjar became first Indian Navy ship to call at heritage coastal port of Gopalpur in Odisha, as part of Aazadi ka Amrit Mahotsav (to commemorate 75th anniversary of Independence) and Swarnim Vijay Varsh (50th anniversary of 1971 War).
 - 🔪 Gujarat will host Biennial Defence Expo-2022 (12th edition) in Gandhinagar in March 2022.
 - VIS approved sale of Harpoon Joint Common Test Set and related equipment to India for estimated \$82 million. Harpoon is an antiship missile.
 - Notice than 76% indigenous content. It is 262 metres long and 62 m at widest part.

 - 🔪 Indian Navy ships INS Ranvijay and INS Kora undertook bilateral maritime exercise with Vietnam Navy, at Cam Ranh (Vietnam).
 - A 'Joint Guidance for the Australia India Navy to Navy Relationship' document signed between Indian and Australian Navies, aligned to the '2020 Comprehensive Strategic Partnership'.
 - Solution Content of Content of

- No. Indian Army organised a 400 Km *JAZBAA-E- TIRANGA* Relay Marathon in In Jammu and Kashmir.
- India and Russia signed deal for immediate procurement of 70,000 AK-200 series assault rifles from Russia. Thus comes amid India and Russia working on a project to jointly manufacture over 6 lakh AK-203 rifles in India.
- First batch of 1 lakh privately made in India modern hand grenades handed over to Indian Army by Economic Explosives Ltd, a Nagpur based private company. This is first instance of ammunition being manufactured by private industry in India.
 - ▶ These new multi-mode hand grenades will replace *Grenade No 36* of World War I vintage design.
- Pakistan launched indigenously developed guided multi-launch rocket system Fatah-1, capable of precisely delivering conventional warheads upto 140 KMs.
- As part of Its ongoing goodwill visit to Europe and Africa, INS Tabar took part in a Maritime Partnership Exercise with Algerian Navy (with ship Ezzadjer), as India's First Naval Exercise with Algeria.
- Ministry of Defence signed a contract worth 1349 Crores with Mahindra Defence Systems, to buy 14 Integrated Anti-Submarine Warfare (ASW) Defence Suits (IADS) for Indian Navy.
- 3rd edition of annual exercise Gandiv held by National Security Guard (NSG), in Multiple cities in Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat and the National Capital Region.
- 26. Raksha Mantri Rajnath Singh flagged-in Indian Army Skiing Expedition *ARMEX-21* in New Delhi, which was conducted in mountain ranges of Himalaya, to promote adventure activity across country.
 - The expedition was flagged off at Karakoram Pass in Ladakh on March 10, 2021 andculminated at Malari in Uttarakhand on July 06, 2021.
- 27. Russia Launched its first stealth naval warship, fully equipped with stealth technology making it hard to detect it by enemy vessels.
 - 🔪 The full stealth warship, Merkuriy naval corvette, is built under Project 20386.
 - Normal Project 20386 is Russia's newest class of corvettes being constructed by *Severnaya Verf* for the Russian Navy.
