General Conditions:

- Interested candidates should apply with a CV (containing qualifications, achievements, age, email ID, and contact number details), passport photograph, and photocopies of relevant documents. The envelope containing the application is to be superscribed with "Application for DST Research Position" and sent to "Administrative Officer-I, UGC-DAE CSR, University Campus, Khandwa Road, Indore-452001 (M.P.)". - Applicants may indicate their priority of the above positions in their application form.
- Last date for submission of application is **22nd July 2025**.
- The age limit for general candidates as of 22nd July 2025 is 28, but it is relaxable up to 5 years for SC/ST and 3 years for OBC candidates as per GoI Rules.
- Selection will be based on an interview (online) and academic background. The interview date for the shortlisted candidates will be emailed to them. Candidates will be required to keep all the testimonials related to education and community certificates (if applicable) in their original form during the interview. The original certificates will be verified for selected candidates. If selected, self-attested photocopies of the certificates and two recent passport-size photographs should be submitted at the time of joining.
- The tenure is co-terminus with the project. If eligible, the selected JRF will be allowed to register for the Consortium's Ph.D. program.
- The offer of fellowship does not, under any circumstances, confer on the candidates any right to absorption in UGC-DAE CSR.
- Candidates working in Government, Public Sector Undertakings, or autonomous Bodies should produce a No Objection Certificate (NOC) at the time of interview if called for the same.
