Applications are hereby invited from the eligible candidates of **Deogarh** district for engagement of Gram Rozgar Sevak (GRS) under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) in different Gram Panchayats of **Deogarh** District on a contractual basis. Engagement of the selected candidates will be for a contract period of one year, which may be extended for further periods subject to appraisal of their performances.

Remuneration and Nature of the job:-

The posts are purely contractual for execution of works under MGNREGS & co-terminus with the Scheme. The selected candidates can be posted in any Gram Panchayat of this District by virtue of the order of appointing authority. The conditions of service of the GRSs shall be as per the guidelines issued to the effect from time to time.

The newly engaged GRS will get a consolidated monthly remuneration of Rs.7,000/- after successfully worked for more than 1 year & less than 6 years will get 8,500/- per month and will get 8,880/- per month after successfully worked for more than 6 years, which may be revised from time to time.

Out of the vacancies mentioned above, the reservation of vacancies in respect of the special categories like Sports Person, Ex-Servicemen and persons with Disabilities (PwD) etc shall be adjusted against the categories to which they belong. Number of vacancies for the said special categories is given below.

There shall be reservation for PwDs with the following two categories of benchmark disabilities under clauses (b) & (c) of section 34(1) of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 namely;

(b) deaf and hard of hearing (HI- Hearing Impaired);

(c) locomotor disability including Cerebral Palsy, Leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid attack victims and muscular dystrophy (O1- Orthopedically Impaired)

Reservation shall be 4% of the total no. of vacancies proposed to be filled up. Out of which, two percent each shall be reserved for the persons with the above two benchmark disabilities.

Applicants claiming reservation under Persons with Disability (PwD) category must ensure that they possess Permanent Disability Certificate and belong to the category and Sub-Category of disability for which the post has been reserved, as mentioned. They must submit a copy of the Unique Disability Identity (UDID) card issued by the Competent Authority. The disability certificate other than the UDID card is not acceptable.

Note: - The number of posts to be filled up by way of this recruitment may increase or decrease without prior notice at the discretion of the authorities. In case of non-availability of the candidate(s) from the category of Ex- Servicemen, PwDs and Sports Persons, the post(s) meant for the said candidates shall be filled up by other candidates from the respective category.

Eligibility Criteria:-

(A) Educational Qualification: (i) the minimum qualification of the candidate should be 10+2 pass or its equivalent qualification as notified from time to time by CHSE Odisha with Computer Proficiency

(ii) The candidate shall be able to speak, read and write Odia fluently and must have

- a. Passed Middle School examination with Odia as a language subject; or
- b. Passed Matriculation or equivalent examination with Odia as medium of examination in non-language subject; or
- c. Passed in Odia as language subject in the final examination of Class VII or above; or
- d. Passed a test in Odia in Middle English School Standard conducted by School and Mass Education Department.

(iii) Computer Proficiency:

- The candidates having computer proficiency of "O" level and use of Odia language in Computer are eligible to apply for the post of GRS.
- 'O' level course of National Institute of Electronics & Information Technology (NIELIT) (formerly DOEACC) is a foundation level course. The candidates having higher computer qualification like BCA, PGDCA, MCA, B. Tech (IT / Computer Science), B.E (IT / Computer Science) can also apply.
- The Electronics & Information Technology Department vide notification No. 435 dated 08.02.2021 has notified that the OS-CIT course of Odisha Knowledge Corporation Limited (OKCL) and O level course of National Institute of Electronics & Information Technology (NIELIT) Certify basic computer proficiency as the course covers foundation- level knowledge in computer application. O level certificate issued by NIELIT and course is given by training institutions accredited with NIELIT which can be verified from their portal (www.nielit.gov.in).
- Other higher courses such DCA, BCA, PGDCA, MCA etc. typically lay emphasis on subjects like Database Management System, Operating System, Software Engineering Computer Architecture, Web Technology, Multimedia and languages such as C++, Java, etc. and are suitable for employments as Programmer, System Analyst, Database Administrator, etc. all these courses need to be certified by Central Universities / State Universities / Deemed Universities / State Private Universities whose list finds place in the Universities Grants Commission Portal (www.ugc.ac.in) or by All India Council for Technical Education (www.aicte-india.org) or **SCTEVT (sctevtodisha.nic.in)**.
