Focus of the research is to mainly study and document the diversity of fauna Netravali and Cotigao Wildlife Sanctuary through field surveys. Project is funded by Research and utilization division, Goa Forest Department, Govt of Goa.

Primary aim of the project is to add hitherto unknown information on diversity and distribution of fauna existing in the above-mentioned areas. This will help us to increase the conservation value towards better habitat management. Study will also initiate conservation awareness among fringe village areas. Besides acting as conservation reference for Goa the project will likely to contribute in filling up the lacuna in faunal knowledge.

The key output of this project will be to develop a comprehensive faunal database that can act as a resource for management and generation of widespread awareness among various section of society.
