The applications of eligible candidates are invited for the post of Field Worker at a fixed salary of Rs. 15,000/- per month in research project "DST-21: Improvement of livelihood status of the Scheduled-Caste SC population of Punjab State through biofloc fish farming and value addition of produced fish" funded by the SEED Division of the Department of Science & Technology. The post is purely temporary and the service of the incumbent is liable to be terminated at any time without any prior notice. The initial appointment will be for six months and shall be extended, subject to satisfactory performance. The incumbent will have no right whatsoever for absorption in the regular university service.

- The relaxation in age and reservation shall be as per Punjab Govt./University rules


Preference will be given to the candidates with knowledge of Punjabi.

Note: If suitable candidate with knowledge of Punjabi is not available, then another candidate will be considered.


Job responsibilities:
