**Project Title** Nationwide assessment of water conservation structure impacts on community resilience using mixed methods study design - Evaluating the impact of artificial lakes, ponds and tanks on local livelihoods across India

**Project Description** A national-scale economic evaluation of asset creation under a large public works programme with a focus on the water conservation structures by using a mixed-methods approach that comprises of geospatial data analysis, qualitative data analysis, causal inference and web development.

**Monthly Remuneration** up to Rs. 20,000/- per month

#### Research Assistant (Qualitative Research)
