PROFESSOR

- i. An eminent scholar with Ph.D. qualification(s) in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline as indicated in the qualifications and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with, a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer reviewed or UGC listed journals and a total research score of 120 as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table 2 of UGC Regulations 2018
- ii. A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and/or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National level institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR

- 1. A good academic record with a PhD Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines as indicated in the qualifications.
- A Master's Degree with at least First Class (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed) in the subjects specified for the posts in the

- Faculty of Fisheries Engineering and at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed) in the subjects specified for the posts in the Faculty of Fisheries Science.
- 3. A minimum of 8 years of experience of teaching and/ or research in an Academic/Research Position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institutions/Industry with a minimum of 7 publications in the peer reviewed or UGC listed journals and a total research score of Seventy five (75) as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table 2 of UGC Regulations 2018.

ASSISTANT PROFESSOR

- 1. The clearing of ICAR/UGC/CSIR NET is mandatory
- The clearing of NET / SLET / SET will not be required for candidates possessing a PhD Degree
 as per UGC Regulations 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may
 be exempted from NET/SLET/SET or ICAR / AICTE Guidelines.
- NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Master's programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.
- 4. A First Class Master's Degree (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed) in the subjects specified for the posts in the Faculty of Fisheries Engineering and at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed) in the subjects specified for the posts in the Faculty of Fisheries Science.
- 5. Other criteria as per UGC Regulations 2018 would also be applicable
- 6. The Academic score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3A) of UGC Regulations 2018 for Universities shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview.
- The amendments if any, issued by UGC with regard to requirement of PhD degree for appointment to the post of Assistant Professors shall be applicable.

General instructions

 A relaxation of 5% marks shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes (OBC)(Non-creamy Layer)/ Differentlyabled ((a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acidattack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.

- A relaxation of 5% marks for the Master's Degree shall be provided, (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master 's Degree prior to 19th September, 1991.
- 3. The time taken by candidates to acquire M.Phil. and / or Ph.D. Degree shall not be considered as teaching/ research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions. Further the period of active service spent on pursuing Research Degree simultaneously with teaching assignment without taking any kind of leave, shall be counted as teaching experience for the purpose of direct recruitment/ promotion.
- 4. The candidates applying for the reserved posts should clearly state the category in which they belong to. They must also enclose attested photocopy of Caste Certificate issued by the competent authority.
- 5. The candidates applying to the post reserved for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) shall produce the Income and Asset Certificates from competent authorities which are appended as Annexures II & IV of G.O. (Ms) No. 23/2022/P&ARD dated 04.10.2022, whichever is applicable, for the benefit of reservation. The candidates shall also fulfill the criteria stipulated in the G.O.(P) No. 1/2020/P & ARD dated 03.01.2020 and G.O. (Ms) No. 2/2020/P&ARD dated 12.02.2020 for considering reservation under EWS category.
- 6. If any vacancy earmarked for Economically Weaker Sections cannot be filled up due to non-availability of suitable candidates belonging to Economically Weaker Sections, such vacancies shall not be carried forward as backlog and such vacancy shall be allotted to open competition in the next phase of recruitment.
- Age limit for applying to the posts shall be as per University Grants Commission / Indian Council for Agriculture Research / All India Council for Technical Education regulations and norms existing or issued from time to time.
- 8. Candidates in service should apply through proper channel or should produce NOC and other

- requirements as per rules, otherwise the applications will be rejected.
- 9. The prescribed essential qualifications are the minimum and mere possession of the same does not entitle candidates to be called for interview. Where the number of applications received is large and/or where it will not be convenient or possible to interview all the candidates, the University at its discretion may restrict the number of candidates to a reasonable limit on the basis of qualifications/experience prescribed in the advertisement. Further, the University may also fill up the posts advertised on short-term contract basis, if necessary.
- 10. UGC Guidelines from time to time shall be applicable.
- 11. The University reserves the right to -
 - (a) not to fill up any or all posts advertised.
 - (b) draw reserve panels for appointment to possible future vacancies;
- 12. The qualification prescribed shall be as on the last date for receipt of application.
- 13. Candidates applying for more than one post should submit separate application for each post and should pay application fee accordingly.
- 14. No interim queries regarding interview/selection will be entertained.
- 15. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
- 16. Interested candidates should apply in duplicate in the <u>prescribed format attached here under</u> along with photocopies of all supporting documents.
- 17. All applicants should submit self-assessment Academic Performance Indicator (Table 3A for Assistant Professors and Table 1 & 2 for Associate Professors and Professors) prescribed in appendix II of the UGC regulation 2018 attached here under with all supporting documents. Without supporting documents, the claim is not accepted.
- 18. Application fee Rs.3000 /- for General candidates and Rs.750 /-for SC/ST candidates
