- Interested candidates, who fulfil the prescribed eligibility conditions as mentioned above, may attend the Walk-in Recruitment on the specified date and time along with the following documents
 - Original certificates/mark sheets/testimonials/experience certificate(s) etc.
 - Bio-Data / Curriculum Vitae
 - One recent passport size photograph
 - Original Identity Proof with one self-attested phot-o copy.
 - No Objection Certificate (NOC) from present employer.
 - Certificate issued by the Competent Authority, in support of SC / ST OBC (NCL) / EWS / PwBD category, if applicable.
 - One set of self-attested copies of all certificate / testimonials.
- Candidates who fail to produce the required documents in original, along with the prescribed self-attested copies, shall not be permitted to appear for the interview.
- The engagement shall be purely temporary and contractual, co-terminus with the project or until the services are no longer required, whichever is earlier.
- The engagement shall be on a full-time basis, and the selected candidate shall not undertake any other assignment, employment, consultancy, or engage with any other organization during the period of engagement without prior approval of the Institute.
- Candidates whose minimum prescribed educational qualification or degree/result is awaited as on the date of the interview shall not be eligible to appear.

6. No increment, Dearness Allowance (DA), House Rent Allowance (HRA), or any other allowance/benefit admissible to regular employees of the Institute shall be payable during the tenure of the contractual engagement unless specifically provided under the project.
7. No TA/DA shall be admissible for attending the Walk-in recruitment or for joining the assignment.
8. The minimum prescribed qualifications and experience may be relaxed in the case of exceptionally outstanding candidates, if considered appropriate by the Selection Committee.
9. The Institute reserves the right to fill or not to fill any or all of the advertised posts, increase or decrease the number of vacancies, modify the requirements, or cancel the recruitment process at any stage without assigning any reason.
10. Mere fulfillment of the prescribed eligibility criteria shall not entitle a candidate to be called for the interview or guarantee selection/engagement.
11. If any information furnished by a candidate is found to be false, incorrect, or if any material information is suppressed at any stage, the candidature/engagement shall be liable to cancellation or termination without notice.
12. The selected candidate shall be required to produce all original documents for verification at the time of joining. Failure to do so shall result in cancellation of the offer of engagement.
13. Candidates already employed in Government Departments, Autonomous Bodies, Public Sector Undertakings, Universities, or other organizations shall produce a valid No Objection Certificate (NOC) from their present employer at the time of the interview.
14. The selected candidate shall be governed by the terms and conditions of the project and the rules, regulations, and administrative instructions of the Institute as amended from time to time.
15. The engagement under the project shall not confer any right or claim for regular appointment, absorption, seniority, or continuation in the Institute after the completion or termination of the project.
16. The decision of the Competent Authority of the Institute in all matters relating to eligibility, selection, engagement, and interpretation of these terms and conditions shall be final and binding on all candidates.
