- **2.6 In Hockey (Men)** for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay Rs. 1900 or Rs.2000 in Pay Band Rs. 5200-20200, participation in the International Tournaments (Senior or Junior) of four or more nations, may also be considered. Semifinalist in Senior National Championships may also be considered for Grade Pay Rs.1900 or Rs.2000 in Pay Band Rs.5200-20200.
- **2.7 In Hockey (Women)** for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay Rs.1900 or Rs.2000 in Pay Band Rs.5200-20200; at least 2nd position in the International Tournaments of four or more nations, may also be

considered. Participation in these tournaments may be considered for recruitment against the posts having Grade pay Rs.1800 in pay band Rs.5,200-20,200."Hockey India" may be treated as the recognised National Sports Federation for the Game of Hockey for the purpose of recruitment.

- 1. MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION: (A) For the post having GP-Rs. 1800: For Civil Engineering, Mechanical, Electrical and Signal & Telecom department:- 10th pass plus National Apprenticeship Certificate (NAC) granted by NCVT or 10th pass plus ITI. For other department:- Matriculation (10th pass) or ITI or its equivalent or National Apprenticeship Certificate (NAC) granted by NCVT. (B) For the posts having GP-Rs.1900/2000: Pass in 10+2 or its equivalent. (C) For the post having GP-Rs. 2400 (Technical): Pass 10+2 in Science i.e. Maths or Physics or equivalent. (D) For the post having GP-Rs. 2800: A university Degree or its equivalent.
- **2.** AGE: 18-25 years as on 01.01.2025. No age relaxation is permissible.
- **3. PERIOD OF RECKONING SPORTS ACHEVEMENTS:** The sports achievements of current & previous two financial years will be taken into account for eligibility. Therefore, the sports achievements on or after 01.04.2022 will only be considered.
- 4. HOW TO APPLY:-The link for online application is available at North Eastern Railway's website www.ner.indianrailways.gov.in. Candidate should carefully read all the instructions given in the Employment Notice before filling the online application form. Online application form should be filled following the step-by-step procedure given on the webpage. All the required fields must be filled-up carefully. Candidates must upload his/her scanned recent photograph and signature while filling the application form.

5. EXAMINATION FEE:

For candidates belonging to SC, ST, Ex- Servicemen, Persons With Benchmark Disabilities (PwBDs), Women, Minorities and Economically Backward Classes	Rs.250	Refund of Rs.250 will be made to the candidates who actually appear in the trial.
All other candidates	Rs.500	Refund of Rs.400 will be made to the candidates who actually appear in the trial.

The requisite examination fee should be deposited online as provided on the webpage of the online application form. After depositing the examination fee the candidates should login again and must take a printout of the application form.

- **6. MODE OF SELECTION & RECRUITMENT PROCESS:** The recruitment will be based on the performance in trial and evaluation of sports and educational achievements.
- GENERAL CONDITIONS OF RECRUITMENT: (i) Before applying, the candidate should ensure that he/she fulfills all the eligibility norms (ii) The specific position played in the particular game/event if applicable must be mentioned in the application form. (iii) The Educational or Sports qualifications acquired after the date of application shall not be considered. (iv) Candidates furnishing false information/suppressing the facts will be disqualified and shall be liable for debarment and legal action. Candidates who attempt fraud/impersonation are liable for debarment to appear in the future examinations conducted for recruitment in Railways. (v) Candidate(s) found eligible for appointment have to pass the prescribed medical examination conducted by the Railway Administration before appointment. (vi) Mere fulfilling minimum eligibility criteria for recruitment or selection of candidates and recommendation for their appointment shall not confer any right on the candidates for their appointment in Railway. (vii) Second Class free journey pass from the nearest Railway Station mentioned in the application form will be issued to the candidates belonging to SC & ST communities whenever they are called at any stage of recruitment. (viii) The person appointed against Sports Quota in the category of clerks will be required to possess proficiency in typing within a period of four years from the date of appointment. If the candidate does not acquire prescribed typing qualification within the stipulated period, increments due after four years and thereafter shall not be released. (ix) Candidates should be in readiness to appear in the trials at a very short notice.

Note: (1) In case of difference between English and Hindi versions of the Employment Notice the English version shall prevail. (2) The decision of RRC/NER in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the application, issue of the free journey pass, penalty for false information, mode of selection, conduct of trial, trial venue, and all other matters related with recruitment process will be final and binding on the candidates. Any enquiry or correspondence will not be entertained in this connection. (3) Railway Administration will not be liable/responsible for any loss/injury/damage, whether direct or consequential, suffered/incurred by any candidates during the recruitment process.
