### 3. Educational Qualification:

Candidate should possess the following requisite Educational Qualification:

(i)	Level-2 Or Level-3 of Pay Matrix as per 7 <sup>th</sup> Pay Commission	Passed 12 <sup>th</sup> (+2 stage) or equivalent examination. Education Qualification must be from a Govt. Recognized Board/Council/Institution.
(ii)	Level - 1 of Pay Matrix as per 7 <sup>th</sup> Pay Commission	10 <sup>th</sup> Pass or ITI or equivalent or National Apprenticeship Certificate (NAC) granted by NCVT.

**Note:** (i) Educational qualification must be from a Govt. Recognized Board/ Council/ Institutions etc. (Minimum educational qualification should be as applicable to the post offered for NTPC posts). (ii) For appointment against Sports quota in Technician-III, the minimum educational qualification is 10<sup>th</sup> pass. However, the training period for such Sports Quota appointees will be 03 (Three) years, unless they pass/ Possess ITI qualification in the relevant Trade, in which case it will be 6 months.

**4. Age:** (a) Minimum age 18 years and maximum age 25 years as on 01-January-2024. No relaxation in upper or lower age limit will be permissible in this recruitment. (b) Proof of Age viz., Matriculation certificate issued by a recognised board or equivalent must be produced / attached.

**5. Period for Reckoning Sports Achievement:** For recruitment against Sports Quota through Open Advertisement, the recognized sports achievement should be in the current and or immediate previous two-financial year and the sports person shall be an active player. The sports achievement in recognized championships / events on or after 01.04.2021 shall only be considered for appointment. For validity of sports achievement, concluding day of the championships events shall be taken into account.

**6. Sports Norms:** The minimum sports norms for recruitment of sportspersons against sports quota in different Grade Pay and Pay Bands for both team and individual events shall be as per the table shown below:

**Note:** In boxing discipline, the achievements of players in "Youth" category or after 25.09.2016 in International Championships will be considered of "Junior" category.

(a) In Athletics, medal winning performance in National Inter State Senior Championships, may also be considered for recruitment against the grade pay ₹ 1900 in pay Band ₹ 5200-20,200.

(b) In Archery, Participation and medal winning performance after 25.11 events organized by Archery Association of India led by Shri Arjun Munda as National Sports Federation for the sport of archery in India will be considered for recruitment.

(c) In Badminton & Table Tennis; sportspersons may also be considered for recruitment on the basis of their current Annual All India Rankings; in different Pay and Pay Bands, as per following criteria:

Only the current Annual All India Ranking shall be considered for purpose. For the purpose the highest ranking may be considered one year for the purpose recruitment. **Ranking in Mixed-Double be considered only in Badminton and not in Tennis and Table Tennis.**

Only the current Annual All India Ranking shall be considered for purpose. For the purpose of recruitment the highest ranking considered valid for one year. **Ranking in Mixed double be considered only in Badminton.**

(d) In Cricket (Women) at international level, representation of Main India Team in a Test Match or in a Limited Overs One Day International Match or 20 Overs Match; shall also be considered for recruitment against the grade pay ₹ 1900 or ₹ 2000 in Pay Band ₹ 5,200 - 20,200/- (Level- 2 & Level- 1). In Cricket (Women) at National level, following sports achievements in One Day Limited Overs/Twenty-20 Overs Women Cricket Championships; organized by BCCI; may also be considered for recruitment against the grade pay ₹ 1800 or ₹ 1900 in Pay Band ₹ 5,200 - 20,200/-

In Cricket Men Section, following achievements may also be considered for recruitment in GP- 2000/1900:

(i) Quarter finalist in Senior/ U-25/ U-19 All India Inter State Elite Group Championships and All India Inter State Championships may be considered for GP 2000/1900

(ii) Participation in Senior/ U-25/ U-19 All India Senior Inter-zonal Championships may be considered for GP 2000/1900

(e) Basketball: The sports achievements in the events conducted by Federation of India after 26.07.2017 shall be considered for recruitment.

(f) Volleyball: The sports achievements in the events conducted by Volleyball Federation of India after 20.07.2017 shall be considered for recruitment. Participator winning performance upto 25.06.2020 in the events organized by Volleyball Federation of India led by Shri Ramavatar Singh Jhakar as Secretary General will be considered for recruitment. But event conducted by Volleyball Federation of India or its affiliates after 25.06.2020 shall not be considered for recruitment. However, the certificates issued by the Association of Indian Universities and the International Federations for Sports Achievements in the Game of Volleyball, will be valid for recruitment.

(g) Boxing: The sports achievements in the events conducted by Boxing Federation of India after 28.10.2016 shall be considered for recruitment. **Note:-** In Boxing the achievement in "Youth Category" in International Championship will be considered of "Junior Category" as per RBE-20/2018.

(h) Power lifting: The sports achievements in the event conducted by International Powerlifting Federation (IPF) or its affiliated units after 03.10.2017 shall not be considered for recruitment. However, the certificates issued by the Association of Indian Universities and the International Federations for recognized sports achievement in International Powerlifting will be permissible for said purpose as per RBE No. 76/2018.

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(i) **Football:** The mandatory condition for recruitment Under-21 players in the Santosh trophy has been excluded. Junior National Football Championship for B.C. Roy Trophy is to be considered for recruitment Under-19. Age condition is to be remained as applicable for other games.

(j) **Weightlifting:** The eligibility for recruitment & trials for considering the cases of Weightlifters having recognized sports achievements as per old and new weight categories, shall be as under:-

\* All the championships should be conducted under the aegis of recognized International/National/State sports and Federations and also recognized by the Railway Sports Promotion Board.

\* A sportsperson will be considered for recruitment only for event/position/game advertised in which he/she has recognized sports norms. Sportsperson having sports achievement/eligibility norms for post carrying higher Grade Pay will also be eligible for post carrying lower Grade Pay. **Separate applications for each category (Grade Pay) should be made along with requisite examination fees.**

**7. Selection Procedure:** Short-listed eligible candidates will be called for -

(i) Trial of sports performance. (ii) Interview and assessment of sports achievement, educational qualification etc.

**NOTE:** Only those candidates who perform better than the existing railway sportspersons in their respective events, and if they fit into the NFRSA team, will be considered for appointment.

**8. Procedure for Recruitment:**

(a) Trials of the candidates shall be conducted to assess their sports performance and suitability for Railway/Unit team as well as Indian Railways team. Trial Committee shall give its recommendation in terms of either FIT or NOT FIT, for consideration for next stage, by giving marks (maximum 40 marks), as per the criteria given below:

(i) For game skill, physical fitness & coach's observations during trials : 40 Marks

(ii) FIT Candidate : Candidate securing 25 marks or more

(iii) NOT FIT Candidate : Candidate securing marks below 25

(b) After Trial only the FIT candidates shall be considered for the next stage i.e., interview stage by the Recruitment Committee. Recruitment Committee shall award 60 marks for sports achievement and educational qualification as per following marks distribution indicated at (f) below.

(c) Recruitment Committee shall take interviews and award the marks (out of 60 marks) only to the FIT candidates for their sports achievements, educational qualifications etc. Candidates declared 'NOT FIT' will not be assessed further by the Recruitment Committee.

(d) Interviews of the candidates shall invariably be held on the same day, just after trials or at the most, next day of the trials.

(e) Recruitment Committee is to add the marks given by the Trial Committee to the FIT candidates (i.e., out of 40 Marks), in order to make the final merit list (out of 100 Marks).

(f) **Distribution of Marks:** Maximum marks which can be awarded by the Trial Committee for performance during Trial and Recruitment Committee during Interview stage, shall be as follows:-

(i) For game skill, physical fitness & Coach's observations during Trials : 40 Marks

(ii) For assessment of recognized Sports Achievements as per norms : 50 Marks

(iii) Educational Qualification : 10 Marks

**Total : 100 Marks**

**Note:** For educational qualification, 6 (six) marks shall be given to th fulfilling only the minimum educational qualification, to the post again: she is being considered for appointment. Candidate having higher qualification shall be given higher marks.

**NOTE:** The offer of appointment shall be given purely on the basis of merit. I than one sportsperson score the same marks, preference should be give candidate to decide the merit.

**09.** All the candidates getting appointment through Sports Quota will under period of two years.

**10. Essential Certificates/Documents Required:** Photocopy of certifica performance, educational qualification, date of birth, caste, etc. should be attested along with the application. There is no reservation for SC/ST/OBC, a sub-quota. However, the candidates claiming to belong to SC/ST communities are required to submit self-attested photocopy of Caste Certi by the Competent Authority. In case of OBC-NCL Certificate, it should not t one year at the time of trial / interview.

**11. HOW TO APPLY:** Candidates fulfilling the eligibility criteria should application format given at Annexure-A by the candidate in his/her own hand good quality A-4 size plain paper along with two recent (taken within last passport size photographs duly self-attested without wearing any wig, cap glasses. The application should be duly filled and signed by the candidate ir handwriting.

**Recruitment against GP ₹1800 (Pay Band-1/ Level - 1) :** Candidates are submit single application for a single event in GP ₹ 1800, Level-1 only, othe candidature is liable to be rejected.

**Recruitment against GP ₹1900 / ₹ 2000 (Pay Band-1, Level - 2 & 3):** Car apply for the event in GP ₹ 1900/-, he / she is also eligible to apply for the ₹ 1800/- if desired.

**Note :** Allotment of post / Division shall be decided by the Railway Ad as per administrative requirement.

**12. FEES:** (i) For all candidates except those mentioned in sub-par ₹ 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred) only with a provision for refundin candidates actually appearing in the trial). The IPO should be drawn in fi /NF Railway, and payable at Maligaon Post Office, Guwahati - 781011 only must write their names & full address in the IPO.

(ii) For candidates belonging to SC/ST/Ex. Servicemen, Women, Mir Economically Backward Classes: ₹ 250/- (Rupees Two Hundred Fifty) provision for refunding the same to those who actually appear in the :

(iii) 'Minority' means Muslims, Christians, Buddhists, Zoroastrians Sikhs. Economically backward classes will mean those candidates whose f is less than ₹ 50,000/- per annum. **13. Medical Examination:** The sportsperson (male/female) appointed, r minimum medical norms for the post, for which he/she is being appointed.

**14. Important Instructions:** (i) Eligibility will be considered only on the information provided in the application. (ii) Candidate who does not posse educational qualification, achievements, sports norms etc. as on date of noti not apply. (iv) The candidate has to fill up required ir his/her own handwriting using blue / black ball point pen. (v) Spellings of name, father's name and in the application form must be as per the original certificates. If any di found, the application can be rejected at any stage of the selection. (vi) Appli is not as per format (Annexure-A) will be rejected. (vii) The candidature may also be rejected if (a) the candidate submits multiple applications for th and category (b) the candidate submits multiple applications with different c the same post & category; (c) the candidate submits multiple applications photo (face) for same post & category. (viii) Unsigned applications OR signa letters OR incomplete applications will be rejected. 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(xi) IPO issued before the date of issue of Employment Notice will not be accepted and the application will be rejected. (xii) Candidates must write their name and address on the IPO and enclose it with the application form with one self-addressed stamped (worth Rs. 6/-) envelope (size 24x10 cm). (xiii) IPO should be drawn in favour of PFA/N.F.Railway and payable at Maligaon Post Office only, otherwise application will be rejected. (xiv) Applications received with cash/cheque/Central Recruitment Stamp OR money order will not be accepted and application will be rejected. (xv) Candidature of those candidates who fail to appear for trials, interview and other selection procedures on the date and venue fixed for the purpose, will be cancelled without further notice. (xvi) Railway Administration reserves all rights for recruitment of sports persons at any time/position for which suitable outstanding sports persons are available. (xvii) The application can be filled in either English or Hindi but item nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 10, 11 & 18 should be filled up in English only. (xviii) Only self-attested copies may be sent with application form. Original Certificates should be produced only at the time of selection/interview. (xix) Selected candidates will be liable to serve on any post/department anywhere in N.F. Railway subject to training courses, if any so prescribed. (xx) Selected candidates will be required to undergo medical examination as per the prescribed norms for different posts. (iv) Application should possess requisite educational qualification and sports achievements on the date of submission of application. (v) Discrepancies in the application submitted would render the candidate ineligible at any time during the selection. (vi) Selected candidates have to pass the requisite medical fitness standards prior to appointment. (vii) Selected candidates will have to submit 'Service Bond' requiring them to serve 5 years with the railway. (viii) Decision of Northeast Frontier Railway in all matters relating to this recruitment shall be final.
