Applications are invited for the post of 1 JRF for Numaligarh Refinery Limited (NRL), Assam, sponsored project entitled "Electrocatalytic Conversion of H_2S and Ammonia in Sour Water to Sulfur, H_2 , and Ammonium Sulfate ".

Eligibility for JRF:

- M.Sc. Chemistry/Physics/Material Science or any other relevant/allied disciplines with minimum 55% marks from a recognized university or equivalent
- 2. Bachelor's/Master's degree in Chemical Engineering with minimum 55% Marks.
- 3. Candidates with GATE/NET (qualified) will be preferred.

Relaxation in minimum qualifying percentage of marks and age limit will be as per Government of India guidelines for candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/Physically Challenged candidates.

Fellowship:

- (i) Rs.37000 per month for candidates possessing a valid CSIR-UGC NET certificate including lectureship or GATE score or a selection through national level test conducted by a central Government agency or Institution will be eligible for full stipend.
- (ii) Rs.24000 per month for candidates possessing minimum essential qualification stated above and not satisfy (i).
- (iii) In campus residence facility may be extended based on the availability.

Salient Points:

- 1. Based on satisfactory performance, the selected candidate may be given a chance to apply for the Institute's PhD programme. However, selection will be based on qualification, experience, and interview.
- 2. The shortlisted candidates will be informed via E-mail/Phone.
- 3. No TA/DA will be paid if called for interview.
