2) For the posts of Assistant Professor mentioned in Advt. No.AP-1/2024 to AP-7/2024 :-

- a) A minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed) at the Master's level shall be the essential qualification for direct recruitment of teachers and other equivalent cadres at any level.
- b) A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes (OBC)(Non-creamy Layer)/Differently-abled ((a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.

- (2) The candidates shall submit hard copy of online submitted application along with true copies of testimonials, certificates, degrees, diplomas and complete list of published research papers to his/her credit if any, in **FIVE** sets to the University Office on or before Last date. Original documents will have to be produced at the time of interview. Postal delay shall not be entertained.
- (3) Applicants are advised to read University Direction Nos. **8/2019, 14/2019, 17/2019 & 50/2019** thoroughly before filling the Application Form & API Score formats. (Available on University Website.)
- (4) Qualifications & Pay matrix are as per UGC/ AICTE/ NCTE and State Government rules, applicable from time to time, for the posts of Associate Professor, Assistant Professor. Qualifications and age shall be considered as on the closing date.
- (5) The candidate shall have to submit along with the online submitted application, a declaration in FORM 'A' as per the rules prescribed by the Govt. of Maharashtra in respect of small family vide Notification No.SRV.2000/CR (17/2000) XII, dt.28.3.2005. Format of FORM 'A' is attached herewith.

- (7) Every such application which is not in prescribed form, late or incomplete will be rejected and no intimation in this regard will be communicated to the candidate.
- (8) No correspondence will be entertained in respect of advertisement, interview, selection & appointment etc.
- (9) No TA/DA will be paid either for attending the interview or for joining the post.
- (10) A candidate furnishing incorrect or false information shall stand disqualified.
