(iii)	Duration	The engagement will be for a period of 12 months, extendable for one (01) more year based on needs of the organization and performance of the candidate. However, the maximum duration will not be extended beyond two years.
(iv)	Essential qualifications	Graduates in Veterinary Sciences / Food Technology / Poultry Technology/B.Sc., Food and Nutrition (04 years course)/B.Sc., Food, Nutrition and Dietetics (04 years course)/B. Tech., (Biotechnology) or related disciplines from a recognized University or equivalent
(v)	Desirable	A postgraduate degree in Veterinary Sciences, Food Technology, Poultry Technology, Biotechnology, Food Science and Nutrition (M.Sc., following a 3-year B.Sc. Food Science and Nutrition programme), or a related discipline from a recognized University or equivalent institution. Knowledge on waste disposal, slaughterhouse by-products utilization, product development, nutritional and sensory quality evaluation
(vi)	Remuneration	Rs. 25,000/- per month only (consolidated). No House Rent Allowance (HRA) will be paid.
(vii)	Age limit	The minimum age under young professional category will be 21 years and maximum 45 years with relaxation as per rules.

2. All eligible candidates are advised to be present at least 30 minutes before scheduled time on the date of interview for completing necessary formalities. No entry/registration after 10:30 A.M as per schedule of Walk-in-interview. Canvassing in any form will disqualify the candidates. The candidate (s) interested to attend the Walk-in-Interview must bring their original documents and typed application in prescribed format as per application details given in the last along with self-attested copies of his/her qualification, experience etc.
3. The engagement of Project Assistant will be on purely temporary basis and the selected candidates shall not have any right to claim for regular appointment under TANUVAS, Chennai. Initial engagement of Project Assistant shall be for one year which is extendable for one more year subject to requirement of the Institute and satisfactory performance of the candidate following evaluation. The TANUVAS, Chennai will hold no responsibility for payment of salary/regular appointment etc. after expiry/termination of the Scheme/Project.
