The Aapyayata Project focuses on developing a synchronised ecosystem of psychosocial intervention for children in government Child Care Institutions (CCIs) in Telangana, based on the Mission Vatsalya guidelines. The 3-tiered approach to psychosocial intervention and comprehensive rehabilitation of children in the CCIs includes facilitating comprehensive rehabilitation intervention, establishing an integrated rehabilitation complex and mapping of CCIs in Telangana. The project is carried out through a tripartite partnership between TISS, Mumbai, Dept of JWCS, WDCW Dept., Govt of Telangana and TASL, Hyderabad. The pilot project is proposed for a year, 2024-2025, which could be extended by 2 more years to establish the model in the State.

The project is located in the Centre for Equity and Justice for Children and Families, School of Social Work, TISS Mumbai.
