About the project

The state of Bihar experiences multiple hazards in the form of floods, drowning, lightning, fire, road accidents, erosion, drought, etc. Given the population density and the extent of poverty among the (predominantly rural) populace, a large section of the – vulnerable – population are exposed to these hazards. As a result, the state of Bihar faces high disaster risk. Since its establishment, the BSDMA has undertaken multiple activities, from formulations of plans, road maps and guidelines to engaging in training and capacity building across various stakeholders with the overall aim of Disaster Risk Reduction and Building Resilience.

The JTSDS, TISS started its journey, with the Centre for Disaster Management in TISS, in 2006, with a generous grant from the Jamsetji Tata Trust. The Centre consolidated nearly sixty years of TISS's committed work in disaster situations and introduced a full-time, taught Masters' programme in Disaster Management in 2007. Apart from academic programmes, the centre/school's key domains of work have been transdisciplinary field action, research and training addressing a wide spectrum of issues cutting across technical, natural and social science disciplines. Currently, the School offers several programmes, including a PhD, although the Masters' programme - MA/MSc in Disaster Management remains the flagship programme with more than 30 students enrolled each year.

To bridge the gap between academia and governance, the Bihar State Disaster Management Authority (BSDMA) and Jamsetji Tata School for Disaster Studies, TISS signed an MoU in Oct 2024 to work on specific areas of joint engagement as agreed upon by the two esteemed institutions. The project proposes to evaluate two flagship programmes of the BSDMA: the Mukhyamantri School Safety Program (MSSP) and the Road Safety Programme. The Training Needs and Competency Assessment will be undertaken across multiple state government levels. This component will identify the disaster training needs and relevant competencies that are essential to become competent public sector professionals in the field of Disaster Management. The research component of the project proposes two vulnerability assessments for Bihar. Research is proposed to conduct a social vulnerability analysis in a select district to develop a multi-scalar, multi-dimensional, comprehensive and contextualized social vulnerability framework using integrated methodologies. The second research component in the project is the Study of Disaster Social Vulnerability and Psycho-Social Well-Being Interface.
