GENERAL CONDITIONS / INFORMATION FOR DIRECT RECRUITMENT:

- 1 All the posts are intended to be filled on a regular basis and eligible citizens of India are entitled to apply for the posts at this Institute.
- 2 All applicants must possess the essential qualifications prescribed for the post applied for and fulfill all other conditions stipulated in the advertisement. Candidates are advised to ensure, before applying, that they meet the minimum essential qualifications, even if they possess higher qualifications. All details furnished in the online application will be treated as final and no changes shall be entertained after the last date for submission of applications.
3. After submitting the online application, candidates are advised to take a printout of the same and send the hard copy along with all necessary supporting documents, including self-attested copies of testimonials/certificates, to the Chief Administrative Officer, AIISH, Manasagangothri, Mysore – 570006.
- 4 The prescribed Essential Qualifications/Educational qualifications are a bare minimum and mere possession of it, will not entitle the candidates to be considered for the post. **Rehabilitation / allied health care professionals shall hold a valid registration with RCI / NCAHP (wherever applicable).**
- 5 The qualifications prescribed should have been awarded by a recognized Universities/ Institutions.

- 6 If a candidate is claiming a particular qualification as equivalent qualification as per the advertisement, then the candidate is required to produce order/ letter / equivalency certificate in this regard issued under signature of the competent authority / University / Institutions etc. The decision of the Director, AIISH in this regard shall be final.
- 7 In case of Boards/ Universities / Institutes awarding CGPA / SGPA / Overall Grade Point Average (OGPA) / Diploma / Degree Grade Point Average (DGPA) / Cumulative Performance Index (CPI) etc., candidates are required to convert the same into percentage based on the formula as per their Boards/ Universities / Institutes. **A copy of conversion formula issued by the authority should be enclosed, failing which the application will be deemed as incomplete and would stand rejected.**
- 8 The appointment of the selected candidates is subject to being found medically fit as per the requirements of the Institute.
- 9 The application has to be invariably accompanied with a ‘**No Objection Certificate**’ from the employer concerned, by those who are already in employment under Central/State Government, Public Sector Undertakings or Autonomous Bodies, duly indicating the name and post applied for. *This shall also be applicable to the candidates working in All India Institute of Speech and Hearing, Mysore.*
- 10 Employees Under Disciplinary Proceedings:
Employees against whom disciplinary Proceedings are pending or contemplated shall not be considered for appointment on Direct recruitment.
- 11 The selected candidates will be covered under the National Pension System (NPS) as notified by the Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India and the scale of pay notified is as per the VII CPC recommendations.
- 12 The posts carry usual allowances i.e., DA, HRA, and TA etc., as admissible to employees of AIISH, Mysuru.
- 13 Candidates are encouraged to apply for posts reserved for the respective category by enclosing appropriate certificates issued by competent authorities.
Age Relaxation: The upper age limit will be reckoned as on the last date prescribed for receipt of applications. [i.e., 45 days from the date of publication in the Employment News Paper at 5.30 P.M on that day].

The Upper age limit mentioned against each post is for general category posts. - 15 The list of candidates found eligible/ineligible will be hosted only on the Institute’s website. Candidates are advised to refer to the same. No separate communication will be sent through the e-Samarth portal or any other mode of communication.
- 16 Any representations from candidates regarding their eligibility/ineligibility, along with valid reasons, must be submitted within 48 hours from the date of publication of the results on the Institute’s website. No correspondence will be entertained thereafter.
- 17 The schedule regarding the written skill test / Practical skill test and subsequent results will be published in the AIISH website www.aiishmysore.in.
- 18 The Scheme of examination, date of examination & syllabus for the each post will be communicated to the eligible candidates via call letter to their respective communication address.
- 19 Mode of selection: For Group B & C posts written skill test / Practical skill test may be conducted and details will be notified in the AIISH website and the eligible candidates will be informed of it in due course.
As per Government of India orders, interviews for posts in Group B & C are dispensed with. The results of the Skill Test(s) when conducted, will only be qualifying in nature. **The final selection for these posts will be based on merit/percentage obtained in the essential qualification as mentioned under each post, from out of the candidates who have qualified in the skill test(s)** and all the updates will be notified in the AIISH website.
- 20 If the number of applicants for a particular post is large, the Institute reserves the right to call only the requisite number of candidates for written skill test / Practical skill test to a reasonable limit after screening and shortlisting in consideration of candidate’s qualification, suitability, relevant experience etc.,

- 21 A candidate can apply for multiple posts subject to fulfilling of the eligibility criteria attached to individual post.
Candidates applying for more than one post **should submit separate online application with fees payment for each post.**

- 27 **Wrong declarations / submissions of false information or any other action contrary to law shall lead to cancellation of the candidature at any stage.**

- 30 The Institute also reserves the right to empanel / waitlist candidate(s) for future vacancies. It reserves the right to fill, not fill or partially fill any of the above posts without assigning any reason or issuing further notice.
