The University intends to hold a Walk-in-Interview for empanelment of Guest Faculty on **July 8, 2026** and **July 9, 2026** at the **School of Education Studies (SES)**, Dr. B. R. Ambedkar University Delhi, **Lodhi Road Campus**, Delhi – 110 003.

Interested eligible candidates are required to register himself/ herself on **July 8, 2026** and **July 9, 2026** from 09:30 AM to 11:00 AM in the **School of Education Studies (SES)** with all their original certificates/ mark sheets with an attested photo copy of each of it and a recent passport size photograph along with the updated Bio-data. No TA/ DA would be provided for attending interview. The candidates not fulfilling eligibility criteria would not be considered for selection process.

The panel will be valid for one year, however, validity of panel may be extended till completion of ongoing Semester, if required. The candidates will be engaged for teaching assignments from the panel as per merit list of the panel after assessing the teaching load during the semester to meet the shortfall of teachers in University due to their long leave or due to requirement of additional teachers for introducing a new course etc. The candidate will be engaged from the panel in the following categories:

Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET:

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. Programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

- The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any other similar agency.

The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

OR

The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

Note: The Academic score as specified in Appendix II (Table 3A) of the UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2018, for Universities shall be considered for short-listing of the candidates for interview only, and the selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview.

B. Age:

The superannuated teachers may also be considered for engagement as Guest Faculty subject to a maximum age limit of 70 years.

C. Honorarium:

The Honorarium for Guest Faculty as per entitlement i.e. ₹1500/- per lecture subject to a maximum of ₹50,000/- per month as per UGC norms.

Guest Faculty will not be treated like regular teachers for the purpose of voting rights or for becoming the members of the various statutory bodies of the University.

The Guest Faculty will not be given the benefit of allowances, pension, gratuity and leave etc. as admissible to the regular teachers.

Other Instructions:

- 1) The recruitment shall be made in accordance with the UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and Other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2018.
- 2) Applicants are advised to go through the relevant UGC Regulation, 2018/ NCTE Regulations wherever applicable, as well as contents of the advertisement carefully and satisfy themselves about their eligibility.
- 3) In accordance with the UGC Regulations, 2018, as amended from time to time along with AUD Acts, Statutes and ordinances, including amendments made thereafter, applicants applying for the post of Guest Faculty at the level of Assistant Professor must submit a certificate in the prescribed format as per Annexure I & II (as applicable) from the concerned University to the effect that their Ph.D. degree is in compliance with relevant UGC Regulations for award of Ph.D. degree.
- 4) Reservation for the SC/ ST/ OBC (Non Creamy Layer)/ PwBD/ EWS applicants will be as per the UGC/ Government of NCT of Delhi policies/ guidelines/ instructions. Applicants seeking reservation benefits available for SC/ ST/ OBC (Non Creamy Layer)/ PwBD/ EWS categories must carry the necessary documents justifying the claim of respective reservation as per UGC/ Govt. of India/ Govt. of NCT of Delhi lists/ rules/ norms. The certificate should be in the format prescribed by the Govt. of India/ Govt. of NCT of Delhi. PWD candidates suffering from not less than 40% of the relevant disability shall only be eligible for the benefit of PWD. Other Backward Classes (OBC – NCL) for the purpose of empanelment under the University shall be the Castes, as notified by the Government of NCT of Delhi from time to time as applicable for Delhi State. Candidate must ensure that they are having valid latest OBC Non Creamy Layer Certificate issued from the Competent Authority of Govt. of NCT of Delhi for the current financial year i.e. 2025-2026. Candidates are also required to ensure that they are covered under OBC Non Creamy Layer as applicable and notified by under the Govt. of NCT of Delhi over till the final conclusion of empanelment process. The applicants must be having the valid OBC Non Creamy Layer certificate as applicable to the state of Govt. of NCT of Delhi till the time of conclusion of entire recruitment process.
- 5) Interested candidates are requested to bring self-attested copies of the following documents along with originals (original will be returned after verification):
 - a) Valid Non Creamy Layer OBC (Delhi) certificate issued from the Competent Authority of Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi for the Financial Year 2025-26. Candidate who does not produce the required OBC (NCL) certificate valid for the FY 2025-26, shall not be allowed for interview.
 - b) Copy of your identity proof.
 - c) Copies of your publications which you may like to present before the Selection Committee.
 - d) Certificate of Date of Birth (Class X/ School Leaving Certificate).
 - e) Certificates of educational qualifications and experience mentioned in your application for the above post.
 - f) Experience letter as claimed in the application form.
 - g) 'No Objection' Certificate from your present employer, if you have not sent your application through proper channel failing which you will not be allowed to appear in the interview.
 - h) Certificate of belonging to Reserved Category, if applicable.
 - i) One Passport size photograph.
 - j) All the certificates in original as mentioned in application fulfilling all the essential eligibility criteria for the said post.
 - k) Kindly note that merely appearing in an interview shall not confirm any right of appointment/selection and you are requested to ensure that you are fulfilling all the essential criteria and nothing has been concealed/ fabricated therein. If at any stage, it is found that any wrong information was supplied or any other eventuality leading to disqualification, then your candidature shall be treated as cancelled.
 - l) Please note that no TA/DA shall be paid by the University for documents verification/ interview.

Note: Kindly take a note that you are required to submit a complete set of documents and duly self-attested copies of all certificates should be strictly in same order and sequence as mentioned in online application.

- 6) Candidates are advised to visit the University website at regular intervals for the updates.
- 7) The process of selection may be by a presentation/seminar/interview or a combination thereof.

- 8) The University shall process the applications entirely on the basis of information/ documents submitted by the candidates. In case the information/documents are found to be false/ incorrect by way of omission or commission, the responsibility and liability shall lie solely with the candidate.
- 9) Applicants who have been awarded Ph.D. from foreign Universities should enclose "Equivalence Certificate" issued by Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi, without which their Ph.D. degree will not be considered.
- 10) The assessment shall be based on evidence produced by the applicant such as: copy of publications, project sanction letter, utilization and completion certificates issued by the University and acknowledgements for patent filing and approval letters, students' Ph.D. award letter etc.
- 11) Relaxations as per UGC Regulations, 2018 on the Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2018 for Universities:
 - i) A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Schedules Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes(OBC)(Non-creamy Layer)/ Differently abled ((a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of the eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualification marks without any grace mark procedure.
 - ii) A relaxation of 5% shall be provided, (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991.
- 12) Applicants serving in Government/Public Sector Undertakings (including Boards/Autonomous Bodies) are required to submit 'No Objection Certificate' on the prescribed proforma from the employer, at the time of interview.
- 13) Any addendum/ corrigendum, if any, shall be posted on our university website <http://aud.ac.in/careers> only.
- 14) The University reserves the right to revise/reschedule/cancel/suspend/withdraw the recruitment process in part or full without assigning any reason. The decision of the University shall be final and no appeal in this regard shall be entertained.
- 15) In case of any inadvertent mistake in the process of selection, which may be detected at any stage even after issuing an appointment letter, the University reserves the right to modify/withdraw/cancel any communication made to the applicant in this regard.
- 16) In case of any dispute/ambiguity that may occur in the process of selection, the decision of the University shall be final.
- 17) If the services of any candidate are not found satisfactory, his/ her services may be terminated forthwith without assigning any reason to him/ her.
- 18) The candidate is required to specifically mention the category to which they belong and upload the caste certificate duly issued by the Competent Authority.
- 19) In case of any dispute, any suite or legal proceedings against the University, the territorial jurisdiction shall be the High Court of Delhi.
