Basic Eligibility

- Candidate must be an Indian citizen and at least 17 years of age.
- The required qualification must be full-time and regular from a recognised institute/university.
- Candidates should have passed the qualifying examination within three years from the closing date of application.
- Candidates awaiting final examination results are not eligible.
- Candidates who have already undergone or are undergoing apprenticeship training are not eligible.
- Only one application for one trade at one location is permitted.

How to Apply

- 1 ITI candidates should first register on the NAPS portal. Degree / Diploma Engineering candidates should register on the NATS portal and complete their profile with the required documents.
- 2 After receiving the NAPS/NATS registration or enrolment number, open the BEML Apprentice Recruitment Portal.
- 3 Complete the BEML online application and submit the required details/documents on or before 08-09-2026.

Important: Applicants should have an active Aadhaar-seeded, DBT-enabled bank account. The name and date of birth should match the Matriculation certificate, Aadhaar Card and bank account records.
