How to apply _____

- 01 Register on the apprenticeship portal at apprenticeshipindia.org/login and keep the confirmation email – it's needed at the walk-in.
- 02 Submit the online application on the TIFR website at tifr.res.in/positions.
- 03 Print the application, attach a recent passport photo, and gather originals plus photocopies of all certificates.
- 04 Report to TIFR, Colaba on the walk-in date with every document listed opposite.

- ☐ Date of birth certificate

Selection procedure _____

Merit is drawn from ITI academic performance and a written test held on the day of the walk-in. Only candidates scoring 60% or above on the final merit list are considered.

Aggregate ITI marks, all semesters	60% weight
Written test – technical acumen, aptitude, reasoning, ITI & maths syllabus (50 marks)	40% weight
Qualifying threshold	60% final merit

- – Only fresh candidates are considered; those who have already availed an apprenticeship are not eligible.
- – On completing training, every apprentice sits the All India Trade Test conducted by the National Council for Training in Vocational Trades.
- – The institute reserves the right not to fill any or all posts advertised. Canvassing in any form disqualifies the candidate.
